

FREDERICTON PICKLEBALL CLUB INDOOR PLAY LOCATION GUIDELINES

(Note: Indoor Tournament Locations not included)

Note that all of the following venues are equipped with a first aid kit and an automated external defibrillator (AED). Please familiarize yourself with the locations of both (click [here](#) for AED location document).

1. Richard J. Currie Center – UNB

(15 Peter Kelly Drive, Fredericton, NB, E3B 5A3)

- One or two recreational gyms (three or six courts) booked for play, depending on availability and demand. Hardwood floor surface. Permanent badminton courts lines are marked. For accurate PB court dimensions, the NVZ line must be applied using painter's tape and removed at the end of play.
- Surface easily becomes slippery; use of wetted mats (stored in equipment room with other PB equipment) is recommended. After play, please hang mats to dry on metal lattice in equipment room.
- REDS Recreation parking permit required (purchase at front desk) that applies to parking lots at Currie Center, Lady Beaverbrook Gym and Lady Beaverbrook Rink.
- Outdoor footwear to be removed in hallway before entering gyms.
- Coat rack inside door to Gym #1. If missing inquire at front desk.
- Peripheral sports equipment (e.g. soccer and hockey nets) can be utilized to block runaway stray balls.
- Wooden benches along end wall can be used while waiting to play.
- PB equipment is stored in room between rec. gyms (request access at front desk if locked). Put log-in book on table (normally provided) next to coat rack.
- Locker rooms equipped with lockers (padlocks not provided) and showers.
- First aid kit supplied by front desk.

2. Journey Church

(131 Duncan Lane, Fredericton, NB, E3B 9T1)

- When building is locked, front door code must be used to open and alarm code must be used to deactivate. When leaving building locked, alarm code must be reset and Allen key used to lock door push bars.
- Free parking in large lot behind building.

- Gym with hardwood floor for three courts.
- Outdoor footwear to be removed in lobby inside front doors.
- Coat rack and bathroom entrances in hallway outside gym entrance.
- PB equipment is stored on shelves marked “Pickleball” in storage room off gym (code required to access). Put log-in book on counter in lobby.
- First aid kit purchased by FPC in ball bucket.
- Chairs can be used outside gym entrance in hall/edge of lobby area while waiting to play. Regardless of where chairs are found when you arrive, before leaving building the chairs are to be neatly stacked in the back of the storage room.

3. Bridge Church

(150 Cowperthwaite Street, Fredericton, NB, E3A 9Y5)

- Play is booked in evenings when building is locked, thus security codes must be entered into the key pad to open the front doors. When leaving, use Allen key to lock door push bars and ensure front doors are locked.
- Free parking in lots in front and beside building.
- Gym with concrete floor for three courts.
- Outdoor footwear to be removed in lobby inside front doors.
- Coat rack and bathroom entrances in hallway outside gym entrance.
- PB equipment is stored on shelves in storage room off gym. Put log-in book on table in lobby.
- First aid kit purchased by FPC in ball bucket.
- Chairs available in lobby while you wait to play. Before leaving building the chairs are to be left neatly arranged in lobby.

4. Hanwell Park Academy School

(2331 Route 640, Hanwell, New Brunswick, E3E 2B5)

- One or two gyms (three or six courts) booked for play, depending on availability and demand. Hardwood floor surface.
- Play is booked on weekday evenings and weekends. Access is provided by staff of the Rural Community of Hanwell.
- Free parking.

- No outdoor footwear is permitted inside. All outdoor footwear must be removed in the entranceway of the facility for participants and spectators. No boots are permitted in any area of the school.
- There is to be absolutely no alcoholic beverages or smoking in or on school premises. Non-compliance will result in an automatic loss of rental time.
- PB equipment is stored in the community use equipment room. No one is permitted access into the community use equipment room other than scheduled staff members.
- Access included to the bleachers, locker rooms, and washrooms.
- First aid kit purchased by FPC in ball bucket.

5. Abony Family Tennis Center

(596 Knowledge Park Drive Fredericton, NB Canada E3C 2R2)

- Bookings are on weekends. Access must be provided by Abony Family Tennis Center (AFTC) staff.
- Free parking in lot beside building.
- Gym with special synthetic floor (professional tennis grade), typically for 8 courts but with capacity for up to 12 courts. PB court lines must be applied using painter's tape and removed at the end of play.
- Outdoor footwear to be removed in entrance area.
- Put log-in book and whiteboard (if applicable) in conspicuous location. There are six nets on wheels (stored behind curtains) that are maintained in the assembled state and only need to be wheeled into place to play.
- First aid kit purchased by FPC in ball bucket.

6. Connaught St. School

(184 Connaught St., Fredericton, New Brunswick, E3B 2A9)

- Bookings are on evenings and weekends. Access must be provided by City of Fredericton (COF) staff, who will arrive no later than ten minutes before our start time.
- Free parking in lot beside building.
- Gym with hardwood floor for three courts.
- Outdoor footwear to be removed in hall outside gym.

- PB equipment is stored on shelves in storage room off gym. Put log-in book in central location near bleachers.
- First aid kit purchased by FPC in ball bucket.

7. Priestman St. School

(363 Priestman St., Fredericton, New Brunswick, E3B 3B5)

- Bookings are on evenings and weekends. Access must be provided by City of Fredericton (COF) staff, who will arrive no later than ten minutes before our start time.
- Free parking in lot beside building.
- Gym with hardwood floor for three courts. Ceiling height is less-than desirable for PB.
- Outdoor footwear to be removed in hall outside gym.
- PB equipment is stored on shelves in storage room off gym. Put log-in book in conspicuous location.
- First aid kit purchased by FPC in ball bucket.

8. Unity Centre

(241 Canada St., Fredericton, New Brunswick, E3A 4A1)

- Access must be provided by Fredericton Christian Academy (FCA), which leases and controls the gymnasium at Unity Centre.
- Free parking in lot beside building.
- Outdoor footwear to be removed in hall outside gym.
- Gym with synthetic floor for three courts. Permanent badminton courts lines are marked. For accurate PB court dimensions, the NVZ line must be applied using painter's tape and removed at the end of play.
- Two end basketball net assemblies currently cannot be retracted (but will be retractable at a future date) and may affect high PB shots.
- Only a 3-foot gap between baseline and lip of stage.
- PB equipment is stored on shelves in storage room off gym. Put log-in book in conspicuous location.
- First aid kit purchased by FPC in ball bucket.
