# **New Tec's Gotta Have Fun!**

We started our inaugural Competitive Round Robin Pickleball League on Monday, May 26th. The Town of Tecumseth purchased 6 nets and dividers for the indoor arena at the Tottenham Community and Fitness Centre. Pickleball court lines were taped onto the arena floor.

We have 24 league members ranked at 3.0 and above. You play 8 games lasting 12 minutes each, with a 3-minute break between games. The league runs for 4 weeks. Game scores are recorded beside each court, after each game. Individual players scores are tallied up each week. The top three players' scores will be recognized at the end of the season.

After the first week we had a request for a bathroom and water fill break. So we scheduled a 6-minute break, between games 4 and 5. We did experience some growing pains.

The first two schedules were made with a random schedule number generator. Some players had multiple games with the same partner on the same night during the first week of play. Mary Parsons directed us to a web site that she has used before. Scott Harris was able to make us a new schedule. For games 1 to 23, over the last 3 weeks, everyone has had a different partner each game. Game 24 on the last night would be the only repeat, same as game one.

After week two, we found that you were having many repeat opponents on the same night. Scott was able to re-run the schedule for the last two weeks, to almost eliminate playing opponents multiple times on the same night. He tweaked the new schedule to show teams on the north court and south court. He also provided everyone with a personalized schedule, with all their games highlighted. Posted them on the glass in front of the penalty box, for pick-up at the start of the night.

Chris Campbell made up game score cards for each court. Veronica has been collecting them. They have a weekly report on the scores.

Thank you Chris, Veronica, Mary, and Scott, for your input and help to improve our pickleball playing experience!
