Playtime Scheduler





Playtime Scheduler (PTS) allows players to sign up for PTS sessions if they have a PTS profile. Every play session on the FPC calendar is now in PTS.

FPC members that wish to play in PTS sessions need to setup their PTS profile in their account with this link: https://playtimescheduler.com/register.php?reg=client For help with your set-up, watch this video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3kSHbSK30m8

Members with a PTS profile will receive an email to sign up exactly 72 hours prior to most scheduled playtime on eligible PTS sessions. Use the Notifications tab in your account to control which emails you will receive. Guests / drop-ins may sign up 24 hours after the PTS session opens up to members.

PTS sessions typically have 6 players per court for regular sessions and drills. If the session is full, add your name to the Wait List.

Your PTS pickleball rating in your profile is extremely important and must match your skill level. Use your DUPR rating, a <u>Pickleball Canada Rating Guide</u> or contact the FPC Ratings Committee to determine your PTS rating. Your PTS rating can be updated at any time.

PTS sessions are for players that have paid court fees, either yearly, seasonally, monthly or the daily visitor's fee.

FPC PTS Rules

- 1. Sign up only for sessions that you plan to attend.
- 2. Sign up only for sessions that include your PTS rating.
- 3. Members will now be able to sign up for a second play session in one day, but this can only be done <u>on the day</u> of play not in advance. Ex: if you are signed up to play on a Wednesday morning, and on Wednesday morning there is space to sign up for a Wednesday evening session, this is now permitted.
- 4. Cancel out of a session at least 2 hours prior to the session start time.
- 5. Players can also communicate with Session members using notes and emails. Posted notes in PTS are to be respectful and must display member's names.
- 6. Visitors, defined as non-FPC members, can only sign up 24 hours after the session is open for sign-up.
- 7. The **Super Seniors Luck of the Draw** session is primarily for members with a pickleball age (as of Dec 31 of the current year) of 70 or over. Members with a pickleball age of 68 or 69 can sign-up 24 hours after the session is open for sign-up.
