LOCATION:

Peace Hills Park, Wetaskiwin, Alberta: Township Road 464 west of Highway 2A -- go past the golf course, over the hill, and turn north at the bottom of the hill. See https://goo.gl/maps/wEehagEvDbD2.

COURSE:

Peace Hills Park has a wide start area, varied terrain, trails, open areas, no pavement, challenging hills, room to pass in numerous places, and a clear run to finish.

To maintain the above schedule, a race may start before all runners have finished the previous race. **Walk-through** for Under-20, Senior, and Masters age groups will be offered at 10:45 a.m.; at 12:45 p.m. for all other age groups. (Please see course map later in this technical package.)

<u>Athletics Alberta Membership</u>: All competitors must be members of Athletics Alberta (or attend an Athletics Alberta member school) or their respective Provincial Athletics Association. No exceptions -- please see https://www.athleticsalberta.com/aa-membership/. (Note: "Day of Meet" memberships are **no longer available**. Membership must be registered before the meet entry deadline of October 30, 2017. (Proof of out-of-province Association registration will be required.))

Only Athletics Alberta full members can receive Alberta Championship medals.

ENTRIES: Due: 6:00 p.m. on Monday, October 30, 2017 Please submit all entries using TrackieReg (https://www.trackie.com/online-registration/). For seed time, please indicate the estimated time for the athlete (which will allow the organizers to determine if schedule adjustments will be required).

ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 per participant (includes \$3.00 Alberta Championship fee). Cheques payable to "GO Athletics ".

AWARDS

- Provincial Championship Medals to top 3 Individuals and teams (scoring members).
- Non-Championship medals will be awarded to non- Alberta athletes who place in the top 3.
- Ribbons will be awarded to places first to tenth Individuals.

Athletics Alberta Team Championships:

- Teams are 6 runners with 4 to score. If a club does not designate their team members prior to the start of the race, the first 6 athletes finishing will be considered the team.
- Scoring: First place scores 1, second place 2, third 3, etc. Lowest total wins.
- Teams having non-Alberta registered athletes are not eligible for Athletics Alberta Team Championship.

In accordance with Athletics Alberta policy, for runners to be considered for the end-of-year recognition as cross-country runner of the year in the Pee Wee through Under-18 divisions, they must compete in their appropriate age group in this championship.

RESULTS

Unofficial results will be posted on-site shortly after each race. Official results will be posted the night of November 4 by Ellis Timing Canada (http://www.ellistiming.ca/CrossCountryCalendar2017.html).
