#### **Guidelines and Rules**

- IFJ regulations apply unless specifically modified in Judo Canada's "Tournament Standards and Sanctioning Policy"
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make changes deemed to be in the best interest of the tournament and competitors
- Weight classes or age divisions may be combined if an unsuitable number of athletes are registered in a particular weight division
- Draw is modified double elimination
- All weights are exact weights except U18 and younger weigh in in underwear with 0.1 tolerance
- Female competitors must wear a plain, white t-shirt under their judo gi
- No kanetsu waza or shime waza are allowed for a novice judoka
- Both white and blue judogi are mandatory for U16 and above
- Single white judo gi are permitted for U14 and earlier
- Single blue is not permitted
- Athletes can only fight in one division per day
- Early Bloomer policy as per page 9 of the 2017 Judo Canada Sanction policy shall apply and a signed waiver request & release (attached) for athletes born 2004 or earlier must be forwarded to Judo Saskatchewan Attn: <a href="https://www.twt.uv.com">tvtaylor@sasktel.net</a> prior to January 15, 2018.
- Group registrations may be completed via the excel sheet however all athletes must sign and submit a waiver

- U10 & U12 do not weigh in but their coach must submit their actual weight on the proper form

- All foreign competitors must show documentation of a valid membership with their National Judo Association
- Minimum Rank of Yellow Belt
- Referees must hold a Provincial A Level
