For an Invitation letter for participants needing a Visa, you will be sent an automatic invitation letter after registering online.

1) Register for the tournament

2) In the online registration, add your passport number, return flight details and your accomodation details

3) Pay for your registration online

4) An automatic email with the invitation letter will be sent to you with all this information listed, which you can use to apply to a local Canadian embassy

5) The Canada Open organizers are not able to contact a Canadian embassy

6) If you are unable to receive a visa to enter Canada, a full-refund will be granted by the registration deadline of May 18. After May 18, no refund is possible
