Alberta Summer Games: Zone 1 Track & Field Team Selection - Technical Package

TIME, PLACE and ENTRY FEE

- Saturday, May 26 and Sunday, May 27, 2018
- Medicine Hat Rotary Track, 1501 Division Ave NE, Medicine Hat
- Midget, Youth, Junior, Senior & Masters: Entry fee for 1st event (\$20), 2nd event (\$15), 3rd event (\$10) and for each event after that (\$7). There is no limit to the number of events an athlete can enter.
- Tyke, Pee Wee and Bantam: Entry fee is \$30 per athlete / day. Multi-event format offered each day.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Due to sanctioning and insurance all entrants must be members of Athletics Alberta / Athletics Canada.

Bantam: 12-13 yrs. of age as of Dec 31, 2018 - born in 2005 or 2006.
Midget: 14-15 yrs. of age as of Dec 31, 2018 - born in 2003 or 2004.
Youth: 16-17 yrs. of age as of Dec 31, 2018 - born in 2001 or 2002.
Junior: 18-19 yrs. of age as of Dec 31, 2018 - born in 1999 or 2000.
Senior: 20-34yrs. of age as of Dec 31, 2018 - born in 1984 -1998.

INFORMATION FOR TYKE, PEE WEE AND BANTAM EVENTS (Multi-Events)

• Tyke, Pee Wees and Bantams will compete in a Multi-event format: 4 on Saturday and 4 on Sunday.

Tyke Day 1: 60m, Standing Long Jump, Shot Put (2kg), 600m
 Pee Wee Day 1: 60m, Standing Long Jump, Shot Put (2kg), 800m
 Bantam Day 1: 80m, High Jump, Shot Put (3kg), 800m
 Day 2: 150m, Long Jump, Discus (750g), 600m
 Day 2: 150m, Long Jump, Discus (750g), 1200m

• Points will be given for placings in each event (10,8,6,5,4,3,2,1) and ribbons given for the combined total for each day.

• Tyke, Pee Wee and Bantam runners do NOT use starting blocks.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENTS LEADING TO SUMMER GAMES

• Sprint Events including Hurdles (400m and Less): Midget and Youth ages MUST use starting blocks.

 Midget Boys: 100m, 84cm/33" high 200m, 76cm/30" high
 Youth Boys: 110m, 91cm/36" high 300m, 84cm/33" high

- o 800g Junior, Senior & Master's Men (Unless otherwise specified by World Masters Athletics)

ZONE 1 – SUNNY SOUTH TEAM SELECTION FOR ALBERTA SUMMER GAMES

- All Sunny South Team information will be posted on the home page, www.southzone.org, in the "more" tab and on the Bulldogs Track & Field Club website, www.medicinehatbulldogstrack.com.
- 44 competitors will be selected for the Sunny South team 22 females, 22 males, in 2 age categories, Midget and Youth
- · Two athletes will be selected for each event; one relay team for each category.

There are no restrictions to the number of events an athlete may enter.

- Athletes who have participated at Legion Nationals are NOT eligible to compete at the Summer Games in the age group they competed in at Legions.

- Athletes who qualify for the Sunny South team will complete a registration form and will be charged a \$135 fee. (This is to offset travel, accommodation, meals, team uniform, which the athlete keeps.). This form and payment (cheque payable to Athletics Alberta) will be collected at the Sunny South Trials from those athletes selected for the Sunny South team. Deadline for registration and payment is June 21.

ALBERTA SUMMER GAMES INFORMATION

- Alberta Summer Games will be held July 19 22, 2018 in Grande Prairie.
- Registration and Opening Ceremonies: July 19. Athletics Competition: July 20 -21, Closing Ceremonies: July 22.
- Athletes will stay at the Athletes' Village and will be chaperoned by the Sunny South Staff. ALL athletes must stay with the Sunny South team from Thursday to Sunday. Bus transportation to and from the Games will be provided to athletes.
