ENTRIES (US dollars at Par) DEADLINE midnight, Sunday, June 10, 2018

With the goal of putting athletes in heats/sections with athletes of similar abilities, the 2018 edition of the Langley Pacific Invitational is combining the 16-34 year old age categories to compete in a single category unless technical specifications will not allow. Heats/sections will be drawn based on seed performances.

The following events will be combined into a single 16-34 age category and heats/sections will be drawn based on seed performances:

100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 400m hurdles (women), Long Jump, Triple Jump, High Jump, Pole Vault, Discus (women)

Due to technical specifications, the following events will have a Youth category:
Sprint Hurdles, Shot Put, Javelin, Hammer, Discus (Men), Steeplechase

Due to technical specifications, the following events will have a Junior Category:
Sprint Hurdles (Men), Discus (Men), Hammer (Men), Shot Put (Men)

- All Pacific Invitational fees are \$10.00 per event before midnight, June 10, 2018
- All Masters Championship fees are \$20.00 per event before midnight, June 10, 2018
- Little Rascals: \$10 for all 4 events combined. Entries will be done at the track Sat. or Sun.

Late Registration and Fee (after midnight June 10, 2018):

- After June 10th, 2018, all Langley Pacific entries will be charged \$20.00 for each event
- After June 10th, 2018 all Master's late entries will be charged \$30 for each event
- From Monday, June 11 through to 11:59 pm on Tuesday, June 12th, late entries can still be done by Trackie
- After 11:59 pm on Tuesday, June 12th, all late entries will be done onsite at Meet Registration, and will only be accepted until 90 minutes prior to the event starting
- Late entries may not receive correct seeding

Divisions:

- Junior Development (J.D.): (9 -13 yrs) single age groupings
- Midget (14-15 yrs),
- **Open (16-34 yrs except where technical specifications will not allow)**
- Little Rascals (age 6,7,8 yrs)
- Masters (scored as single entry group)

BC Athletics Membership

- All Masters must be a BCA member or equivalent in another jurisdiction to complete

Finalists - 60M and 100M

- 60/100M events with 8 or less competitors will be run as a final at the time of the heats.
- All other track events will be run as finals
- Finalist will be determined by IAAF Rules

Track Events

- Events may be run up to 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time

BC Athletics Membership

- All Masters must be a BCA member or equivalent in another jurisdiction to complete.

Throws & Horizontal Jumps

- Ages 9-13 receive will receive 3 attempts
- Midget through Open and Masters receive 3 attempts; top eight qualify for 3 additional

Conflicting Track/Field Events

- To avoid missing jumps or races, athletes should report to BOTH event Officials. Athletes cannot “catch up” on missed rounds of throws/jumps.

Results

- Results will be posted at the track and on www.langleymustangs.com

Awards

- First Nation designed medals will be available. Ribbons: 4th through 8th.
- BC Masters competitors will receive BC Athletic Medals: no additional ribbons
- Medals MUST be picked up at the meet – there will be NO mail out of medals or ribbons

Protests

- After discussion with the event referee, further protest must be submitted in writing to the Chief of Officials and the Jury of Appeal within 30 minutes of the posting of the results.
- A \$25.00 protest fee is to accompany all protests. If the protest is upheld then the protest fee will be returned. JURY OF APPEAL: A jury of appeal consisting of three competent and qualified persons will be available for decisions arising from protests. All Jury of Appeal decisions are final.

Important Notes:

- Track events will run Wheelchair (100 – 1500m), then Oldest to Youngest, Women and then Men, with the Exception of Hurdles which will run by event Distance - longest to shortest
- **Little Rascals'** (age 6,7,8) 4 events of ball throw, hurdles, standing long jump and 50 meters starts on the infield, **Sunday at 11:30 am.** Registration for Little Rascals at the track only.
- If there are 8 runners or less, events will run as finals during the scheduled heats
- **60M/100M finalists will be determined by heat winners plus fastest times to fill available lanes**
- Track events are a rolling start and may run up to 30 minutes ahead of schedule
