Note: All participants must come to the official weigh-in with their judo membership card, their accreditation pass and with a picture ID. Athletes in U16, U18, U21, Masters, Ne Waza and Ne Waza Masters who wish to fight in another division Sunday (in the same weight category) will NOT have to make weight again. However they have to go to the weigh-in on Saturday afternoon to confirm their participation in the second division on Sunday.

\*Only one attempt to make weight is permitted once on the official weigh-in scale.

## REGISTRATION

### REGISTRATION

**Athletes who wish to participate in a second division must pre-register for all the desired categories. No registrations will be done on site.**

Until Friday October 18<sup>th</sup> 2019, 23 h 59 : Regular rates apply

From October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to October 25<sup>th</sup>, 23 h 59 : 10\$ Late fee / division

From October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to October 28<sup>th</sup>, 23 h 59 : 35\$ Late fee / division

*\*50% discount on Ne Waza registration if it is a 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> division*

#### *Judo Québec can manage exceptional cases*

- 40\$ fees when registering an athlete for a 2<sup>nd</sup> division. \*Open division excluded.
- Athlete registered in a 2<sup>nd</sup> age division must confirm their participation to this division at the logistic table before the end of the Saturday weight-ins.
- Athlete that does not make their weight division will automatically be put in the next weight division. Without any additional fees.
- 20\$ penalty fee will incur for all mistakes made in an athlete's registration (belt or age division) that will force changes to categories after the first draws are completed.
- 15\$ administration fees will be held for all cancellations between October 19<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> 2019.
- There will be No refunds following a cancellation as of October 29<sup>th</sup> 2019. No matter the circumstances.
- 10\$ will be charged to coaches who have not registered by October 18<sup>th</sup> 2019 and requiring an accreditation for the tournament.
- Athletes may only register in one weight category per division.

### COACHES

- Online registration before October 18<sup>th</sup> 2019 is **MANDATORY** for **ALL** coaches.
- Coaches meeting will be held at the competition site Saturday at 7:30 am.
- Coaches must be certified NCCP II or Dojo Instructor trained.

### ACCESS

- Access to the competition area reserved for athletes will only be granted to coaches and athletes with an accreditation card. Online pre-registration for all athletes and coaches is **MANDATORY**
- Access to the stands are free for all spectators.
- No bag will be allowed in the competition area. Also, for cleanliness reasons, no food or beverage will be allowed in the competition area.

### REFEREES

- Referees must be members of Judo Quebec, another Canadian association or of a recognized IJF association.
- All referees must be certified National A or above.
- Referees willing to participate in the tournament must confirm their presence by October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to Jessika Therrien at [jtherrien@judo-quebec.qc.ca](mailto:jtherrien@judo-quebec.qc.ca).
- There will be a referees meeting Friday evening at 19h30 pm at the competition venue. Coaches are welcomed to attend as well. Referee suit mandatory.



## TOURNAMENT RULES

1. IJF and/or Judo Canada's tournaments rules will be applied.
2. All submissions (strangulations and arm-locks), Drop Soei Nage and Sankaku are forbidden for the U14 age division. (U14 athletes meeting early bloomer clause and entering an older age division will be subject to the older age groups regulations.)
3. Arm-locks are forbidden in U16 age division. (U16 athletes meeting early bloomer clause and entering an older age division will be subject to the older age groups' regulations.)
4. Modified double elimination system and/or pool depends on the number of registrations.
5. Tournament's software will be used to make the draw prior to the competition.
6. Organizing committee can modify certain weight categories should there be too few athletes in a division or category.
7. The competition will take place on 7 different 8mx8m mat surfaces.
8. Fighting with a single white judogi will be accepted for the U14 division only.
9. White and blue judogis are mandatory U16 and over (or white-blue reversible)
10. Athletes can only fight in one age division per day, except those fighting in the open or ne-waza category.
11. An athlete registered in two different age division who doesn't fight in his first age division will obligatory have to weight-in for the second age division.
12. Coaches who get caught lending their coaching accreditation will get their accreditation confiscated and won't be aloud to coach in the rest of the tournament.
13. All requests for athletes born in 2006 or later to fight in another age division must be sent to [tournoi@judo-quebec.qc.ca](mailto:tournoi@judo-quebec.qc.ca) by October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019. All applications must come with a recap of past results and the early-bloomer waiver. All applications will be forwarded to Judo Canada.

## LENGTH OF MATCHES

- U14-U16-Masters-Ne Waza : 3 min.
- U18-U21-Senior : 4 min.
- Golden Score will apply in U16, U18, U21, Senior, Masters, Ne Waza and Ne Waza Masters divisions.

## NOTICE FOR QUEBEC AND CANADIAN JUDOKAS

- For Judo Québec athletes, the tournament is one of the qualifiers for the U16, U18, U21, Senior, Master and Ne Waza Nationals. The tournament also counts towards the provincial ranking of the U14 division.
- Quebec Open's senior and junior (U21) division gives Canadian athletes points towards Judo Canada's ranking system.
- The Quebec Open is also a tournament that serves as a qualifier for the 2020 U18 Elite Nationals for all Canadian athletes.

## ELIGIBILITY

**All participants (Athlete, Coaches and Referees) must be member in good standing of a provincial judo association.**

350\$ in prize money for both men and women Open category provided there are a minimum of 5 participants in their respective divisions.

## QUEBEC OPEN MEDALS

Medals will be awarded to winners in U14, U16, U18, U21, Masters, Ne Waza, Ne Waza Master and Open.

## QUEBEC OPEN TROPHEES

Trophies will be awarded for all first place winners in the senior divisions. Medals will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd place winners for both men and women.
