QUALIFYING STANDARDS

The top 50 seed times (race results from 2017-2019) for men and women registered in the Canadian 5k Championships will race in the Elite section.

All other 5k runners will run in the Open sections in the morning and results will be separated after the fact between Open and Canadian 5k Championships.

COURSE

5k: The 5k course will be along Assomption Blvd in Moncton, NB with start line in front of Downing St. Course outline will be released in the coming weeks.

1k: The 1k course will be along the trails at Riverfront Park. Course outline will be released in the coming weeks.

Chip timing by Atlantic Chip for the 5k.

The Canadian 5K Championships is sanctioned by Athletics Canada and Canadian Masters Athletics.

The Open 5k and 1k You Fun Run are sanctioned by Run New Brunswick.

Awards

- Top 3 male and female overall in the Canadian 5k Championships will be awarded medals by Athletics Canada
- Top 3 male and female Masters in each age group of the Canadian 5k Championships will be awarded medals by the CMA (ages 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70+)
- Top 3 male and female high school athletes in the Canadian 5k Championships will be awarded prizes (ages 14-18).
- Finisher medals will be given to all runners in the Canadian 5k Championships and the Open 5k.
