Athletes to bring their own chairs, towel, pit tarp/Landing Pad or heavy blanket and water bottle etc.

As social distancing will be maintained, there will not be an athlete tent set up. Heated washrooms are nearby.

Spectators will not be allowed in the jumps area. We will have space on the grass east of the roped-off jumps area and south of the jumps area on the hill. Spectators and athletes are encouraged to bring your own chairs, tents, blankets—whatever you need to be comfortable outside for a few hours. Social Distancing must be maintained—family bubbles are welcome to sit together.

Single event meet, decision of the officials is final, dispute to be addressed to the BC Athletics Official within 30 minutes of the occurrence.

By registering your athlete, you are signing the following:

Any changes in these answers between registration and the event will require the withdrawal of the athlete.
