WKF Dress Code :

- ◆ Clean White Gi
- ◆ Pant and jacket cuffs cannot be rolled up
- ◆ Gi Pant length must cover at least two thirds of the shin
- ◆ Gi Jacket must cover the hip but not longer than three quarters thigh length
- ◆ Gi Jacket sleeves must be no longer than the bend of the wrist and no shorter than halfway down the forearm
- ◆ No hakama will be permitted for kobudo performances;

The tournament director reserves the right to split, change or combine any divisions. Girls and boys divisions will not be combined.

BLACK BELT DIVISIONS (LETTER CODES):

For individual black belt divisions, you will be asked to upload 2 different kata to allow us to deal with larger pools if necessary. You will be asked to designate your 1st or "A" kata, and 2nd or "B" kata in the registration form.



The Sato Cup follows Karate BC Video Guidelines

Competitors are reminded to select a safe location to perform and record their kata, and to comply with all applicable COVID-19 related laws and restrictions in their jurisdiction.

Technical Specifications

In order to ensure consistency in the submitted Kata videos, all competitors are asked to adhere to the following technical specifications when recording and submitting their kata videos:

- The entire body of the competitor, from head to toe, must be visible throughout the kata performance with good lighting. PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE ENOUGH SPACE—NO SHUFFLE STEPS!
- Include 5 seconds of video at the beginning and at the end of the Kata performance.
- The competitor should state the performance is for “Sato Cup 2020” when in the ready position just before bowing and announcing the name of the kata before the performance.
- The camera should be placed directly in front of the competitor, with a maximum camera position angle of 45 degrees from the front of the competitor.
- No edits of any kind are permitted to be made to the video. The entire kata performance must be recorded using a single camera, and in a single, continuous take.
- A minimum video resolution of 720p (1280x720) is required. Most smartphones are capable of recording at this resolution.
- Sound must be recorded in conjunction with the video. The recording must take place in a location with minimal ambient noise.
- The video must be filmed in the horizontal format.
- NO BUNKAI for team kata!!
- Name each video using the following format:

First Name_Last Name_Kata Name
