CODE OF CONDUCT

As a Blue Devils athlete, I am joining a team where I strive to contribute to upholding this positive space, so that myself and my teammates can get the most out of sport, and ultimately be the best versions of ourselves. Therefore I will always work to uphold the Code of Conduct below.

- 1. I will respect my fellow teammates and coaches with both my language and my actions. I understand that in order for myself and others to participate fully in sport, I need to help create a safe space in which everyone can thrive with the same opportunity. Any inappropriate, offensive, or discriminatory language or actions will not be tolerated because it detracts from the positive environment necessary to excel, and therefore may take away from another's opportunity to participate fully in athletics.
- 2. I will uphold sportsmanship by treating athletes, coaches, and officials of other clubs with the same respect I show to my own team both inside and outside of competitions.

OFFENCE POLICY

Blue Devils operates on a 4-strike Offence Policy, in the event/s that an athlete's actions conflict with our Code of Conduct.

First Offence

- The coach will talk with the athlete at practice and work to resolve the issue. *Second Offence*
 - The coach will contact the athlete's parent to notify them of the issue and all 3 will work together to resolve the issue.

Third Offence

• The athlete will receive a 1-week suspension from BDAC practices to learn that actions have consequence, that our practices are to always remain a safe space, and in life you must treat others with respect to function effectively within society.

Fourth Offence

• The athlete will be expelled from the club, and may or may not receive a refund on the registration fee paid.
