COMPETITION SITE

All events, meetings and weigh in will take place at the **Steveston Community Centre** in Richmond BC, which is right beside the Steveston Marial Art Centre at <u>4111 Moncton Street</u>, <u>Richmond</u>, <u>BC V7E 3A8</u>. The competition will be held in the Net Shed (building behind and the main Community Centre building) and the weigh and accreditation will be held in the gym in the Community Centre.

ELIGIBILILTY

All participants must be a member of a provincial judo association, of Judo Canada or of an association recognized by the IJF. Proof of valid membership and photo ID will be required at weigh-in.

No refunds will be issued after April 1st unless the competition is cancelled due to the pandemic, in which case full refunds will be issued.

All participants must pre-register by the deadlines for this tournament. This includes coaches, referees, athletes, and chaperones.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

For athletes and referees:

- 1. All athlete participants and all referees must submit proof of vaccination at the official weigh in.
- 2. All athletes and referees must submit a written Coronavirus declaration in the approved form, signed, and in the case of minors, signed by the participant's parent or legal guardian.
- 3. Wear a mask at all times, except when warming up and competing, or when refereeing.

For all other participants (including but not limited to, coaches, organizers, volunteers, medical team, etc.):

- 1. All other participants ages 12 years or age and older must show proof of full vaccination prior to entering the venue
- 2. All other participants must submit a written Coronavirus declaration in the approved form, signed, and in the case of minors, signed by the participant's parent or legal guardian.
- 3. Wear a mask at all times and maintain a 2m distance

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded for first, second and third place. All medal winners must win at least one match.

RULES

Format of all age divisions as per current <u>Judo Canada Sanctioning Policy & Tournament Standards</u> unless specified below. Any modification to the recommended format must be approved by Judo Canada in advance.

U14:

- Preferred tournament format: round robin, pool system, or modified double elimination. No golden score.
- In weight categories with five (5) or fewer competitors, the round-robin format will be used.

U16, U18, U21 & Senior

- The modified double elimination format will be used.
- In weight categories with five (5) or fewer competitors, the round-robin format will be used.

All issues/cases(s) that are unexpected or deemed exceptional circumstances will be solved by decisions taken by the Judo Canada designated Chief Official in cooperation with the Tournament Director

DOPING CONTROL

Each participant in the Pacific International is subject to a doping control according to regulations by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES). Athletes and coaches must be familiar with these regulations. You can access the CCES Policy at: www.cces.ca.
