Covid-19 Protocols:

Everyone aged 12 or older entering the tournament venue will be required to present proof of vaccination and 19+ will also be required to present Government issued photo identification. All athletes must show proof of vaccination to participate. For those 12 years and older two doses are required, for ages 5 to 11 one dose is required for proof of vaccination.

All participants (including but not limited to athletes, referees, coaches, organizers, volunteers, medical team, etc.) must submit a written Covid-19 virus declaration in the approved form, signed, and in the case of minors, signed by the participant's parent or legal guardian. A link to an electronic form will be sent to all registered participants the week prior to the tournament.

Everyone entering the tournament venue will be required to wear a mask at all times, unless actively warming up or competing.

Eligibility:

All contestants in this tournament must be members in good standing with Judo BC & Judo Canada.

U14 minimum rank - yellow belt

U16 minimum rank - orange belt

All other athletes must be a minimum rank of green belt

Ne-Waza Categories:

U21 & Senior Men	U21 & Senior Women
Light (around -73kg)	Light (around -52kg)
Medium (around -90kg)	Medium (around -70kg)
Heavy (around +90kg)	Heavy (around +70kg)

Ne-waza means ground techniques, therefore this category has no throws. Competitors start in a kneeling position and fight only on the ground. For more information, please see [Judo Canada Ne Waza competition Rules](#)

Youth Provincials Categories:

Placement in age categories is determined by competitor age as of December 31, 2022, as per the [Judo Canada Age and Weight Divisions Standards 2021-22](#).

Earlier Bloomer:

U14 (minimum green belt) must complete an earlier bloomer waiver to fight in U16. This waiver must be signed by both a parent and a coach. First year U16 (minimum green belt) must request permission from Judo BC to fight in U18 and approved athletes must submit a waiver signed by both a parent and a coach.

Uniforms:

All competitors must have a white Judogi.

Blue Judogi are required for U16 & up.

U14s fighting in U16 must have a Blue Judogi
