JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PENTATHLON CHAMPIONSHIPS

Saturday July 2nd, 2022

Okanagan Athletics Club is pleased to invite the BC Junior Development Track and Field community to Kelowna for the 2022 BC Athletics JD Pentathlon Championships. This event is for athletes born 2009-2013. The Pentathlon event consists of five events – 60m/80m hurdles, long jump, high jump, shot put and a 600m/800m run. Participants receive points for each event based on their performance. At the conclusion of the 5th event, all performance points are added up. Winners are determined by the largest points accumulation.

This event will be held in conjunction with Okanagan Athletics Club's annual Jack Brow memorial track & field meet (July 1-3)

- Location: Apple Bowl Stadium 1555 Burtch Rd, Kelowna, BC V1Y 4A9
- Parking: Adjacent to the stadium
- Facility: 400m curbed, urethane, 8-lane track: urethane run up areas for jumps and the javelin: concrete throwing circles: World Athletics standard hammer/discus cage and 100m field: pole vault facility: dressing rooms with washrooms and showers: covered seating for 500 spectators, an additional 400 seats uncovered: a concession is located at the North end of the stands.

Weather: Usually sunny, low humidity, average temperature 25-28 degrees Celsius.

- 1. BC Athletics Competitive Athlete Members for 2022, or
- 2. BC Athletics School or School District Club Members of 2021-2022 (valid from Sept. 1, 2021 June 30, 2022), or
- 3. BC Athletics School Day of Event Members paid at the time of entering the Championship (Valid from Sept. 1, 2021 July 3rd, 2022)

Technical Information:

- a. High Jump increments of 3cm
- b. Long Jump and Shot Put 3 attempts
- c. 600m and 800m will run 2 sections if participation numbers warrant.
