Code of Conduct - Athlete

Parents, please read, discuss & complete with your child(ren)

CRJC requires 1 form per family

Conduct in the School (Dojo):

- At all times, students must respect and obey the instructor and other higher-ranking belts and show respect for the Dojo (school).
- Conduct yourself in a formal, respectful manner at all times when in the Dojo.
- Play time prior to class is a privilege and should be done so in a respectful and safe manner; failure to do so will result in loss of the privilege.
- Do not interfere in any way with the class in progress.
- At no time engage in horseplay on the training area or in the Dojo.
- Unnecessary roughness, crude language, or display of ill-temper is forbidden.
- The uniform should be complete and clean at all times.
- Always observe mat etiquette in the training area, including bowing when entering or leaving the mat area.
- **Wearing footwear (sandals) in the Dojo at all times when NOT on the mats.**
- Remove all jewelry before entering the mat area.
- No chewing gum or food is allowed on the mat or training area.
- No one under the influence of alcohol or a prohibited substance may train.
- As a sign of respect please refrain from wearing hats inside the Dojo.
- Smoking is prohibited in the Dojo.

Conduct During Class:

- **BE SAFE.** Every student must act appropriately and in a safe manner. All students have the right to feel safe and know that they will not be injured from another student who is acting unsafely.
- **BE RESPECTFUL.** All students must show proper respect to instructors and fellow students. All students are expected to listen to their instructors and respect what they have to teach. Judo is a sport of mutual benefit whereas 2 students learn opposing skills while practicing together. It is very important for all students to respect each other.
- Prompt attendance is expected.
- There will be no unnecessary talking during instruction periods.
- You may ask questions during class by raising your hand and waiting to be recognized.
