5. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Facilities and Logistics:

Parking: Free parking. Buses are requested to park at the back of the parking lot.

The race route itself is the inner loop that is darker than the lines on the outside.



Washrooms will be available in the clubhouse. **Portable potties** will also be available on-site.

Medical Services:

Student therapists will be on site and can give access to ice and indoor facilities for those in need of emergency treatment. There is a hospital approximately 6.9 km from the competition site.

Entry Declaration:

All participating teams must fill their men's and women's rosters of 7 designated runners, plus up to 2 alternates on www.trackiereg.ca no later than **Monday, October 24**.

Please note:

- Alternates must be identified;
- Rookies must be identified with an R and date of birth with day/month/year included

All submitted rosters will be communicated to all teams by the end of the day on **Wednesday, October 26**. The final declaration of rosters will take place at the championship technical meeting.

AUS Management Committee:

The AUS Championship Management Committee shall consist of the Meet Convenor, AUS Sport Chair (or designate) and the Meet Official.

The Management Committee shall rule on all matters necessary for the championship to proceed and will, in addition, act as the Protest Committee at the championship. The committee members will be presented at the technical meeting.

6. MEETINGS

Championship Technical Meeting:

A championship technical meeting will be held on **Friday, October 28 at 7:00 pm** in the Brudenell Room at the Rodd Royalty.

The AUS Cross Country Chair or designate shall chair the meeting and all teams are asked to have a representative present. If a school does not have a representative present at the technical meeting, the electronically submitted roster shall be considered as the official roster.

Final declarations of team entries will be done at the technical meeting. As per AUS regulations, either of the 2 designated alternates may be added to the active roster up until 60 minutes prior to race time by submission to **Ron Annear** at e-mail annear@upe.ca. Should an alternate(s) be added to the active roster, all head coaches shall be notified of the change.

Post-race award meeting:

This meeting will be held immediately following the men's race at the finish line area.

AUS Year-End Coaches Meeting:

The AUS coaches meeting shall take place at a date to be determined after the U SPORTS championship. Martine LeBlanc will provide notice of meeting and agenda items at a later date.
