#### **BY THE NUMBERS:**

Locally:

- □ > 100, Whistler Pickleball Association
- ~700 Public School Students (K-7) and Staff



Provincially:

- PBC membership quickly approaching 12 000
  - More than doubled since 2020
  - Approximately 30% of all Canadian players are in BC
- > 75 Organized Associations/Clubs/Affiliates



Nationally:

PCO just reached 40 000 members, Oct 5<sup>th</sup>

South of Us (2021 Data):

- On average 66 new locations opened each month
- > 10 000 dedicated multi-court facilities





# OUR 2022 PICKLEBALL MASTER PLAN



#### Assertions / Key Points:

That the future development of dedicated pickleball facilities:

- □ Follow the learning curve of peer communities, PBC and TBC,
  - ✓ Develop independent, dedicated Pickleball court hubs across the RMOW
- Be public, affordable, managed and maintained by the Municipality,
  - ✓ Across the continent, outdoor is free, indoor ranges \$0.60 to \$5 /hour
- Designed and constructed for easy maintenance and longevity,
  - ✓ Such as utilizing debris removal gates, concrete fence foundations, etc.
- Optimally sited for neighbourhood/family utilization and accessibility
  - Near washrooms, trails, bus service, with bike racks, accommodations for the mobility challenged, parking, etc., and
  - As specified, PB court size and layout requirements are different than tennis
