ABOUT THE SPEAKERS:

Bill Heikkla: Skill and Technique Development for the Javelin

Bill has over 45 years of coaching in Ontario, and is a javelin coach with the Ottawa Lions TFC. Bill has served as a coach at the 1982 Commonwealth Games, 1983 IAAF World Championships, 1986 Pan Am Junior Championships, 1987 Pan Am Games, 1990 Commonwealth Games, 1993 World University Championships and 2001 Jeux de la Francophonie. As an athlete, Bill was a Javelin thrower at the 1968 Olympics, 1967 Pan Am Games, and the 1970 Commonwealth Games.

Danielle Chow-Leong: Self Management and Therapy for Throwers

Danielle Chow-Leong is a graduate of the University Of Toronto's Physical and Health Education Programme and then went the Sutherland & Chan where she graduated and became a RMT in 1999.

Since 2013 Danielle has worked with Athletics Canada and has travelled as part of the Medical Team to multiple Olympic Games, World Championships, Commonwealth Games, and many training camps. Danielle believes that massage therapy plays a key role in optimizing the body for high performance, managing life's stresses, and is essential for long-term health and wellness.

Bogdan Poprawski: Aspects of Speed, Strength, and Power in the Throwing Events

Canada's national team head coach at the 1997 world championships in Athens, Greece, Bogdan brings a wealth of knowledge to the 2022 National Throws Summit. He was an Olympic team coach in 1998 and 1992 and the personal coach of three Olympians – Ray Lazdins (1988), Steve Feraday (1988, 1992) and Jason Gervais (2000).

Richard Parkinson: Lessons on Rotational Shot Put

Richard's International coach experience includes 18 national team-coaching assignments, including: 4 World Championships, 2 Pan Am Games, 2016 + 2020 Olympic Games, and the 2018 + 2022 Commonwealth Games. In 2022, he led Canadian shot putter, Sarah Mitton, in setting a new Canadian Record of 20.33m, winning Commonwealth Games gold, and a 4th place finish at the World Athletics Championships.,

A highly technical and analytical planner, Richard is relentless in monitoring and tracking each athlete's training progress to ensure that they successfully perform on the specific day it when it counts. In constant pursuit of high performance success and providing the very best training and technical advances for his athletes to he has developed long-standing relationships with some of the very best throws coaches from across Canada and around the world.
