The Steveston Judo Club cordially invites Judokas to participate in the Steveston Judo Tournament. This is a development tournament to encourage as many judokas yellow belt and above to participate, **which includes senior divisions up to blue belt (2 kyu)**. Yellow belt is the minimum rank for all divisions – **no white or white/yellow belts** will be allowed to compete.

We are including a Kata competition. To encourage participation there will be Senior and U23 Kata Divisions.

Currently, there are no COVID-19 related restriction in BC or for any judo activities in BC. Proof of vaccination is not required for any ages. No specific health and safety protocols are required, although wearing of masks is recommended. Please be aware that there may be unanticipated changes to protocols, the venue, and schedules. We will issue an updated Technical Package with any confirmed changes and will communicate any further updates as quickly as practical.

All entries and fees must be received on or before **November 12. No entries or payment will be accepted after November 12 or on the day of the tournament.**

Entry Fees: - \$35 U10 / U12 / U14 (yellow and yellow/orange belts)
- \$65 for all other divisions
- \$35 when competing in a 2nd division or Kata

***Note:** As per Judo Canada athletes are allowed to compete in 2 divisions on the same day.

Eligibility: All participants must be members in good standing with their respective judo associations. Proof of valid membership may be requested at the weigh-in/ check-in.

NON-MEMBERS – If you are not a member of JudoBC or Judo Canada please upload to Trackie your membership from whichever federation/association you belong to.

Early Bloomer Waivers

The following athletes can compete in a second higher division:

- U12 (2012) can also register for U14
- U14 (2011 & 2010) can also register for U16
- U16 (2008 & 2009) can also register for U18

Parents must sign early bloomer waiver and upload on Trackie

Check in/Weigh in: November 19, 7:30 am, Net Shed
Check Proposed Timetable for weigh in and start times for each division.
All competitors must submit **actual** weight in kgs with registration.

****Please be on time, weigh in times will be strictly observed so the tournament can start on time.**

In order to streamline check-in, **there will be no weigh-in for Novice Divisions U10.** Club coaches are responsible for reporting accurate weights as round robin draws will be made based on reported weights. A **penalty fee of \$20** will be charged to any contestant who fails to qualify for his or her entered weight division. Athletes can only change divisions if the tournament draw can accommodate such a change.

Tournament Director has the right to check contestant weights and alter divisions accordingly. Novice athletes must report at the tournament site as per division.

All other contestants (U12 and above) must report to the weigh-in at the scheduled times on Saturday, November 19, 2022. Weigh in location to be determined and announced when finalized. See timetable below for approximate weigh-in times.

Important: Weigh-in times and Division Start times are approximate and may be adjusted depending on numbers of competitors. Please watch for tournament updates, and re-check schedule on morning of tournament. Please be ready for your division 30 minutes before times indicated

Rules: Judo Canada Tournament Standards will govern where possible.

I.J.F. Rules will apply, except for the following:

- All competitors must have a White judogi. Girls must have a white t-shirt.
- Blue and White judogi's are mandatory for the U16, U18, U21 and higher divisions **except Novice**.
- Judo Canada medical rules for all divisions up to and including U16. IJF medical rules apply for U18, U21 and Intermediate Seniors.
- U18 and younger - If a Judoka is rendered unconscious, they are out of the tournament. U21 and Senior rendered unconscious does not result in automatic withdrawal.

Rules Continued

- For U10, U12 and U14 divisions, the referee shall stop the match when Drop Seoi-nage, Kubi-nage (headlock throw), Maki-komi, Tani-otoshi, and Sutemi-waza techniques are attempted.
- No Kansetsu-waza and Shime-waza for Novice judoka orange belt and below (all ages)
- Any contestant is entitled to a rest between contests for a period equal to double the match duration of his or her previous match.
- Golden Score for all Divisions except Novice Divisions

Elimination: Novice divisions U10, U12, & U14 will be round robin. Judoka will be grouped accordingly.

All other Divisions will be modified double elimination. Divisions with less than 5 contestants will compete in a round-robin format with wins counted first, then points. If there are only 2 competitors in a division, it will be best two out-of-three.

Kata: Competitors may perform the following Kata

- NAGE-NO KATA (3) & (5)
- KATAME-NO KATA
- JUNO KATA
- GOSHIN JUTSU-NO KATA
- KIME-NO-KATA

Medals: **All medal recipients must be in their Judogi's when receiving medals.**
All U10, U12 and, U14 Novice participants receive a participation award.
Medals will be awarded for first, second and third in all other divisions.
Participants must win at least one match in order to win a placement medal.
Medals will be awarded immediately after each division is completed.
