Eligibility: Must be a paid up member of Judo Ontario in good standing. Athletes must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents.

Age: 2005-2008 inclusive*

*Judo Canada will apply the early bloomer clause in the case when Provincial/Territorial associations nominate athletes younger than born in 2009, see the 2023 CWG Judo Technical Package for more details.

Athletes must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents. A permanent resident is defined as someone who has been granted permanent residency prior to the start of the Opening Ceremony. Permanent residents have a Record of Landing (IMM 1000), a Confirmation of Permanent Residency (IMM 5292), a Permanent Resident Card, or any other document deemed eligible by immigration Canada as proof of their status.

For athletes excluded from games based on Senior Team status and/or participation in major world events, see the 2023 CWG Judo Technical Package.

Rank: Green belt and higher

Weight Categories

Male: -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, +81kg **Female:** -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg

Note: Selected athletes <u>Must</u> compete at the Canada Winter Games in the same weight division that they qualified in.

Note: Due to his IJF world ranking Lasha Tsatsalashvili will be pre-selected for -73kg. Athletes competing in -73kg will be competing to be an alternate.. Athletes with injury requests must submit proper documentation prior to the Canada Winter Games Qualifier to info@judoontario.ca to be considered by the HPC for a fight off.

Rules: NSO and PSO **U18** rules will apply no matter if there is an early bloomer athlete competing in the weight category. True double elimination will be used for divisions of 6 or more. Round Robin will be used for Divisions of 5 or less.

Notes:

-Both White and Blue properly fitting judogis are mandatory. Reversible White/Blue Judogi will be accepted.

Note: All participants must come to the official weigh-in with a photo ID.

The Canada Winter Games will be held in Charlottetown PEI. The judo competition will be held during the second week of the Winter Games from March 1st, 2023 to March 4th, 2023.

2023 Canada Winter Games PEI Athlete Selection Criteria



Travel, accommodation, meals, and uniforms are provided free of charge to all CWG selected athletes and coaches by Team Ontario.

2023 Canada Winter Games Judo Technical Package

Athlete Eligibility:

- Born in 2005-2008*
- Minimum rank: Green Belt.
- Athletes must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (1)
- Athletes must be Judo Ontario and Judo Canada members
- Athletes must be in good standing with PSO & NSO.

*Judo Canada will apply the early bloomer clause in the case when Provincial/Territorial associations nominate athletes younger than born in 2009, see the 2023 CWG Judo Technical Package for more details.

(1) Athletes must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents. A permanent resident is defined as someone who has been granted permanent residency prior to the start of the Opening Ceremony. Permanent residents have a Record of Landing (IMM 1000), a Confirmation of Permanent Residency (IMM 5292), a Permanent Resident Card, or any other document deemed eligible by immigration Canada as proof of their status.

For athletes excluded from games based on Senior Team status and/or participation in major world events, see the <u>2023 CWG Judo</u> <u>Technical Package</u>.

Athlete Quota:

7 Males (Maximum of two competitors per weight division, providing that the maximum size of a team does not exceed allocated quota)

7 Females (Maximum of two competitors per weight division, providing that the maximum size of a team does not exceed allocated quota)

Weight categories:

Female: -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, +70 Male: -50, -55, -60, -66, -73, -81, +81

Athlete Selection:

1. First Priority:

Any athlete that has Judo Canada development carding at the time of the Canada Winter Games qualifying event will be automatically selected for the Canada Winter Games team in the weight division in which they are carded, and will be exempt from competing at the Canada Winter Games qualifying event.

2. Second Priority:

Any athlete who places first at the Canada Winter Games qualifying event will be automatically selected for the 2023 Canada Winter Games Team unless their weight division has already been allocated to a Judo Canada development card athlete.

3. Third Priority:

In the event a weight division has no registration at the Canada Winter Games qualifying event, the division quota will be reallocated to another weight division in accordance with the sequence below:

- a) An athlete who places first at the Canada Winter Games qualifying event but was not automatically selected because their weight division quota was allocated to a Judo Canada development card athlete.
- b) An athlete who is a 2022 Canadian U18 Open National champion in the same weight division they competed in at the Canada Winter Games qualifying event.
- c) If more than one athlete is tied after Priority 3 (b), then the athlete with the best result at the Ontario Open will be selected for their weight division, respecting the athlete quota.
- d) If more than one athlete is tied after Priority 3 (c), then the athlete with the best result at the Quebec Open will be selected for their weight division, respecting the athlete quota.
- e) If more than one athlete is tied after Priority 3 (d), then the Judo Ontario High Performance Committee will make final selection based on medal potential at the Canada Winter Games, respecting the athlete quota.
