Primary Purpose & Intent of Competition:

The primary objective of the Golden Bears and Pandas Preview (GBP-P); Golden Bear Open (GBO) & Pandas Open (PO) is to provide a high-quality competition for USPORTS athletes. All decisions about scheduling and seeding are made with that interest in mind.

All three home events are open to the public to enter and provide enhanced competitive opportunities for interested athletes. All USPORTS events are governed by Canada West Playing Regulations All Club window – U12/ U14 / U16 / U18 / U20 / Senior / Masters events are governed by WA rules

Eligibility:

Athletes and coaches must appear on a formal USPORTS eligibility roster or be active member of their respective provincial athletics association. International athletes should contact the meet director.

Inclusion into USPORTS categories:

This occurs by invitation. It is assumed entries made within club entries, specifically the U20+ category desire to be included in USPORTS sections. At the closure of entries top entries within the U20+ category will be considered and included into USPORTS sections as deemed appropriate by the event management team. These decisions will be made after the closure of entries. Individuals should check the meet program and start lists when they are published as per the timelines indicated.

Coach Registration

Coaches who are not members of university coaching staff's must register in advance (same deadline as athlete entries). To be considered a coach you must be:

- a) Actively registered with respective provincial athletics association
- b) Have a current CRC completed, Safe sport course via coach.ca completed, completed Making Ethical decisions and be in training, trained or certified in the appropriate NCCP context

Seed Marks:

Seed marks are subject to verification using Athletics Canada Indoor Rankings or USPORTS Rankings (Jan 1 2022 – Tue week of event in 2023). This occurs through the automated process in trackie. Special requests for speculative seeds not found in either of the two primary ranking systems must be sent to meet director by Tuesday at NOON, with clear rationale provided in order to be considered.

1st event - \$30; 2nd event - \$25; 3rd event - \$15 Relays - \$30

Entry Limits – GBP-Preview

Field event entry limits are imposed at the GBP-P (Jan 7, 2023) event. The top 10 verifiable entries + Golden Bears and Pandas athletes will be included. Only Sr. specifications will be used

Schedule notes:

Tentative schedules are posted at each of the above links

Major schedule differences between GBO & PO:

- At the GBO, whenever possible men compete before women. At Pandas Open women compete before men.
- GBO has Open/USPORTS 1000m on Saturday, while Pandas Open has 1000m on Friday
- 300m is timed final at GBO, while Pandas Open is Heats/Finals in the Open/USPORTS category

Event & Time Emphasis

Friday Night + Saturday Afternoon = USPORTS & Top Entries by invite

Saturday AM, PM + Sunday Sections = Remaining senior events and all other events offered

Preferred Lanes, order of events and advancements:

Preferred lanes: Oval preferred = 6/7/5/4/3/2/1Order of events: Timed finals run FAST to SLOW

Alternates in finals:

For events having heats and finals, alternates in the finals will be listed. Meaning, if 8 athletes advance to the final, places 9-11 will be listed as alternates. Alternates will be permitted to race in the final should scratches occur in time.

300m / 4x200 Lane Draws:

Timed Final Structure / Golden Bear Open

Top (fastest athletes) seeded in Lanes 6, 7 & 5 respectively according to seedtime. Remaining (slower athletes) seeded in lanes 4, 3. Example: Seed #4 would be Heat 2, Lane 6

Heats/Finals Structure / Pandas Open

Heats are arranged according to seedtime in Lane 6, 7, 5, 4, 3 (ie not random draw) Finals are a two section final of 4 athletes seeded in lanes 6, 7, 5, 4 according to heats performance

Call Room / Check In / Numbers

- USPORTS Track Events:
 - o <u>By 1 hour prior to event</u>: Athletes are required to check in & confirm their intention to compete 1 hour prior to the event;
 - o <u>By 15min prior to event:</u> Athletes are required to come back by 15 min prior to event to pick up their hip number;
- USPORTS Field Events:
 - o Check in on site
- Numbers worn on back for races that finish in set lanes. Numbers worn on front for races that do not finish in set lanes. Hip numbers on right hip

USPORTS Minimum measurements

- A minimum measurement procedure will be in place for USPORTS – Long Jump & Pole Vault events. Marks will only be measured for distances above

LJ: Women: 4.50m and above
PV: Women: 3.00m Opening height
Men: 5.50m and above
Men: 3.50m Opening height

Event Offerings:

GBP-P (Jan 7, 2023)

<u>Track:</u> U14/U16/U18/U20/Senior/Masters: no entry limits: 60m, 60mH, 200m, 300m, 4x400m <u>Field:</u> Senior specs only, top 10 entries regardless of age: Weight Throw, Shot Put, High Jump, Long Jump

U14/U12:

- To support hurdle development 60m hurdles and 150m events will be offered for U14 and U12 age categories. U12 hurdles will use breakdown/scissor hurdles;
- 2nd years in the U14 category are permitted to enter U16 age class events at both GBO and PO.


