



Barrie Pickleball Club Guest Policy & Procedure

Barrie Pickleball Club welcomes guests to come try the sport at no charge. We know your guests will love it!

Guest Policy

Local non-member residents are welcome to play as a guest, during club events, up to 2 times, after which they must become a member. A local resident is generally defined as anyone within a 1-hour driving radius of Barrie.

Guests outside of the 1-hour driving radius will be assessed guest playing privileges on a reasonable and individual basis.

Examples of non-local Guests:

- 1) a player visiting Barrie from Florida for a week, may join as a guest and play as often as they'd like for the duration of their 1-week visit.
- 2) a player living outside of the 1-hour driving radius, wishing to play regularly in the summer, fall or winter seasons must join the club after their maximum allowed 2 guest passes.

Guest Liability Waiver

All guests are required to sign a liability waiver before joining any scheduled Club time or event. The waiver is attached and can also be found on the bottom left corner of the [Barrie Pickleball Club's](http://barriepickleballclub.ca) website. The waiver must be emailed to info@barriepickleballclub.ca prior to the guest attending, with a note indicating in which session/event the guest will participate.
