6. CHAMPIONSHIP VENUE

Mission Recreation Park – 855 Lexington Drive, Kelowna

- A two-kilometre loop course that provides modest terrain changes (mostly flat with a few rises) within a large well-appointed city park with plenty of parking (off Lexington Rd and Lequime Rd), which is expected to serve as host course for the 2024 USPORTS Championship.
- Buses and vehicles can drop off in front of Kinsmen Center (small building in front of finish line). Small vehicles are asked to park behind the baseball diamonds (labelled on map for small vehicles). Buses can park in the southwest corner of the parking lot in front of the Capital News Center (CNC) / H20 Aquatics & Fitness Center (4075 Gordon Dr). Lexington Drive loops around to Gordon Dr and is easy for bus pick-up & drop-offs.



7. COMMUNICATIONS / MEDIA

As the event is a pre-cursor to hosting the USPORTS Championship in 2024, we are aiming to provide enhanced live stats (ie, individual and team after each 2km lap).

During the Championships, UBCO Heat therapy staff will be present, including a certified Athletic Therapist. First-Aid spotters will be placed throughout the race, with the main first-aid station at the Kinsmen Centre near the Start/Finish zone. Should an emergency arise, activation of BC Emergency Medical Services will occur. Visiting teams are expected to provide their own medical representative.
