

## **KJC Teen-Adult Novice-Intermediate Regional Mini Shiai 2024**

**Tournament Site: Kensington Judo Club**

**Purpose:** To provide shiai experience to aid in the development of local novice and intermediate level competitors.

**Entry Fee:** \$40.00 - **registration fee per competitor** for the *first* division entered;  
**\$35.00 fee per competitor** for *each additional* division.

**Weigh-in:** Honor System. Clubs should record competitor weights when submitting entry form. There will be a scale for spot checks should concerns arise.

**U-16 & U-18: 8:30am Check in & Warm Up → 8:45 am Competition Start**

**U-18 & U-21: 10:00am Check in & Warm Up → 10:15am Competition Start**

**Senior & Veteran: 11:30am Check in & Warm Up → 11:45 am Competition Start**

**Eligibility:** All competitors must be in good standing with Judo Canada prior to the tournament.

### **Minimum Rank & Maximum Ranks:**

Minimum Rank to compete is yellow

Novice Categories are Yellow and Orange Belts

Intermediate Categories are Green and Blue Belts (no brown or black belts allowed)

**Age Categories are as of year ending December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024.**

**Exhibition Matches or moving categories:** We will make every effort to move competitors around to the closest age, weight, and experience level while also providing for a good tournament experience. This can happen prior to or during the tournament as time allows.

**Elimination:** Round Robin.

### **Contest Rules, Match Times and Divisions:**

No kansetsu-waza (joint locks) for U16 divisions

No kansetsu-waza (joint locks) or shime waza (choking) for novice divisions

Novice divisions will maintain standard grips, no dropping techniques or sacrifice throws.

As this is a developmental tournament, referee's will start with warnings rather than penalties during the course of a match.
