1. MEDALS:	For kata events medals are awarded to both tori and uke as follows:				

- One pair: 1 set of gold (participation medals).
- Two pairs: 1 set of gold and 1 set of silver.
- Three pairs or more: 1 set of gold, 1 set of silver and one set of bronze.

The same team may not receive two (2) sets of medals in a specific division. They will receive medals according to their highest placing only and the next team following them will then be placed at the following rank.

SURFACES: There are two (2) surfaces of competition of eight (8) meters by eight (8) meters with a four (4) meter security between them.

white strips of tape, 50 cm long, will be fixed at six (6) meters at the center of the competition area to indicate the starting positions for Tori and Uke. There will also be a tape indicating the center of the competition area.

INJURIES: If Tori and Uke are not able to pursue for reasons of an injury, sickness, or an accident in the during the execution of the kata, the pair will be eliminated from the that specific kata division

In case of Minor injury like bloody wound, broken nail or a problem with contact lenses, according to the decision of the judges, the Kata execution will be stopped, and the athlete will be assisted by the medical team out of the competition area. The competition will continue, and the pair will repeat entirely the Kata soon after the last called pair of the division.

In case a new Minor injury happens to the same athlete during the second execution of Kata, the pair will be considered out of competition for that specific kata

In the case that Minor injury happens after a forgotten technique or a major mistake, the pair will be considered out of competition for that specific kata.
