TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES & RULES

- IJF rules apply. Judo Canada and Judo Alberta regulations as of the tournament date will be enforced. The Tournament Director reserves the right to make any changes in the best interest of the event/contestants.
- White judogis are mandatory for all age divisions. Blue is optional for U10, U12, U14, Novice/Intermediate divisions.
- White & blue judogis are MANDATORY for all Advanced U16 & older (novice divisions excluded)
- Novice divisions may be combined with Intermediate or Advanced divisions if low registration.
- If withdrawing from Sunday's division, advise joseki (head table).
- White gi is required at the podium to receive medal.

Edmonton International Judo Championship reserves the right to close all registrations when capacity has been reached or late registration deadline; whichever comes first.

The focus of the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) is on athlete's competing at International and National levels, all judo events in Canada are subject to Canada's Anti-Doping Policy and are subject to unannounced doping control.

COACH ACCREDITATION - <u>www.TrackieReg.com/2024-EIJCCoach</u> ENSURE COACH ACCREDITATION IS CURRENT.

Coaches MUST apply by February 29, 2024) or until capacity is met (no exceptions)

- Provincial/HP Coaches must be minimum NCCP Trained Competition Development.
- Assistant/Other Coaches must be NCCP Trained Dojo Instructors.
- Trained Dojo Assistant can coach U10, U12 and U14 ONLY.
- 1 coach per athlete is permitted mat side. Maximum 4 coaches/Dojo will receive accreditation.

Coach wristband and lunch tickets can be picked up at joseki (head table) after 3 PM Friday, March 8 Athletes who coach <u>MUST</u> register and be properly NCCP certified Register by February 17, 2024 to receive a t-shirt.

REFEREE SYMPOSIUM/COACHES MEETING

A figure often overlooked in a judo competition is the third person on the mat. Referees are responsible for more than casual observers may give them credit for. They are responsible for ensuring fair competition between two fighters abiding by a set of rules. A referee's level of involvement in a match will often affect the overall flow of competition, which ultimately affects what we view as spectators. Referees are needed to make a competition possible. No matter how you encounter judo, the Referee Symposium provides useful tips and information for personal development and training on the rules.
