## **RULES & EQUIPMENT REGULATIONS, PLUS MODIFICATIONS**

The competition uses WKF rules, with modifications, all explained below.

### **ATHLETE ONLINE REGISTRATION**

- Individual divisions: online registration is completed by athletes or parents.
- Team Kata divisions: online registration is completed by club coach AFTER the individual athletes have been registered in individual divisions by themselves.  
*See below for team kata registration*
- The tournament director reserves the right to combine or split divisions in order to create better competitive experiences for athletes.
  - Athletes may elect to challenge up in proficiency, but cannot challenge down. (i.e. a 'novice' athlete can challenge an 'intermediate' division, but not the other way around).
  - In the event that two or more divisions of different proficiency are *merged*, the combined division will adopt the ruleset of the lowest division, with the exception of Kata, where all permitted kata up to and including the highest merged division of proficiency will be allowed (but kata may be repeated if a novice division is included).
- *Division Timetable* to be emailed to participants approximately 24-48hrs before the event.
- *Division Draws* will be released on the morning of the event.
- In the event of a division of 5 athletes, should an athlete be ineligible for a second match via repechage, the tournament organizers will strive to offer a second 'experience' match, depending on the tournament running to schedule. The outcome of this match will not affect final division standings.

### **TEAM KATA REGISTRATION NOTE:**

1. Athletes are registered into individual divisions first.
2. After individual registrations are finished, a club coach can complete a kata team registration by choosing from the individual athletes already registered.

### **DIVISION QUALIFICATION**

1. Please use your best judgment to determine which divisions you qualify for in regards to registration.
2. The karate style chart listed below is simply a guide to help any karate style athlete determine their divisions, even if their own dojo style is not listed.
3. This event is open to all karate athletes who wish to compete under the WKF rule system.
4. Numbers indicate KYU or a pre-black belt RANK, as normally a Kyu rank is designated a belt color, different from dojo to dojo.
5. DAN means a black belt DEGREE, from SHODAN (1st degree) upwards.
6. EXPERIENCE relates to years practicing karate in the dojo.
7. Athletes may register to challenge **up** in division proficiency, but cannot challenge **down** (i.e. a 'novice' athlete can challenge an 'intermediate' division, but not the other way around).

The reason for a permitted kata list is to provide athletes with a more balanced and fair competition which matches their development level. Allowing Advanced & Black Belt athletes to perform any WKF kata helps them to acquire more tournament experience with their highest competitive kata prior to challenging elite divisions in the future.
