Time: Saturday, June 8th at 9:00am

Purpose: To provide a competitive experience in a collaborative environment to aid in the development of local young competitors.

Entry Fee: \$30.00 (regular deadline), \$60.00 (late deadline)

Weigh-in: Honor System.

There will be a scale for spot checks should concerns arise. We ask that Club Instructors verify the athlete's weights. Discrepancies between reported weights and actual weights may result in disqualification without refund.

Caping: We capped registration to **30 per age division**, for a **maximum of 150 participants**.

Eligibility: All competitors must be in good standing with Judo BC prior to the tournament deadline of **June. 5, 2024 11:59pm**.

Minimum Rank will be White/Yellow Belt for U10-U14. White Belt for U8 only.

Maximum Rank will be Orange-Green Belt (Green not accepted).

White-yellow belt Will start by default in Ne-Waza, (ground work)

Categories for

- U8 (2017 & 2018)
- U10 (2015 & 2016)
- U12 (2013 & 2014)
- U14 (2011 & 2012)
- U16 (2010 & 2009)

Male and Female categories separate where possible.

U8, U10 & U12 may be mixed gender.

Elimination: Round Robin.
