



The 38th Victoria Track Classic

DATE: Wednesday, June 12th 2024 – 6:30pm-9:00pm

LOCATION: [Centennial Stadium at the University of Victoria](#). Please note that paid parking is required.

ELIGIBILITY: Current BC Athletics/Athletics Canada membership or equivalent membership from another association.

REGISTRATION: Registration will be done through trackie.com ([click here](#)). Athletes must be registered either through their club or as unattached.

ENTRY FEES: \$35.00 per athlete. Note Trackie will add an additional insurance surcharge for non-Athletics Canada members for insurance purposes.

ENTRY DEADLINES: Please submit registrations no later than 11:59pm PST on Sunday June 9th. We will have a limited number of heats available so registrations will also close if the meet becomes fully registered.

MEET PACKAGES: Bib numbers & hip stickers can be picked up at Centennial Stadium on Tuesday June 11th between 5pm and 7pm OR at the Check-In desk on race day.

MEET RULES: As a sanctioned event, all Athletics Canada and World Athletics regulations will apply vis a vis equipment, competition rules, and anti-doping. Officials reserve the right to spot check equipment compliance with regulations.

- Maximum Spike Length is 7mm (excepting Long Jump and Javelin where it is 9mm)
- Blocks will be provided by the meet
- The infield is out of bounds for spectators. *Athletes and Coaches only.*
- Race numbers will be worn on the back for events 100m-400m and on the front for events 800m and upwards.
- As a World Athletics sanctioned event, limitations on stack height apply to track spikes. Officials are required to carry out random spot checks and failure to comply may result in retroactive disqualification.

MEET RESULTS: Results will be available online, provided by Swann Timing – link to follow closer to meet.

SCHEDULE:

Check-In: Athletes must check in at the check-in tent no later than 30minutes before the beginning of their event.

The Track Classic will endeavour to stick to the scheduled start time of races, i.e. we will not run ahead of schedule.
