The <b>2024 Saint John Track &amp; Field Classic</b> is organized by the Saint John Reds Track & Field Club in conjunction with Athletics Canada and Athletics New Brunswick. The event is a National Permit Meeting (Category "E") for World Athletics Rankings. <b>Facility:</b> The Canada Games Stadium is equipped with a Beynon 1000 surface. Spikes must be pyramids, towers or "trees" of a maximum length of 7mm; needle spikes will not be permitted.	<b>Installation:</b> La surface du stade Jeux Canada Games est Beynon. Les crampons doivent être des pyramides, tours ou « arbres » de 7mm maximum; les aiguilles ne sont pas permises.
