Legion Qualification:

Submissions are due by the **conclusion of the meet on July 14th**. All athletes will be required to show a birth certificate or ID.

Seeding:

For accurate heat/lane assignments, seed times are required for all athletes in U16-Senior categories. These seeds will be verified by the Trackie/Athletics Canada database.

Marshaling

Field events: Please check in with the official at the event site 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

Track events: Please check in at the marshaling area 20 minutes prior to the start of the event to check—in and pick up hip numbers

There will not be announcements made to report to the marshaling area. Failure to check in at the marshaling area at least 20mins prior to your event may result in disqualification.
