- » All individual race courses are two laps and require a lap of the cinder running track
- » Footing is primarily close-cropped grass with some short hardpack, mud, and gravel sections
- » All athletes, teachers, volunteers & spectators are to stay on course trails at all times there is poison ivy off trail
- » Please note there is an apiary within 5m of the run course which is separated from the course by brush and fencing
- » Athletes are responsible for knowing and running the correct course see included course maps

Results & Awards


- » Finish times and placings will be published for all athletes in each classification medals will be awarded for top 3

Other Event Details

- Athletes are responsible for knowing and running the correct course
- Headphones are not permitted
