The Steveston Judo Club cordially invites Judokas to participate in the Steveston Judo Tournament. This is a development tournament to encourage as many judokas yellow belt and above to participate, **which includes senior divisions up to blue belt (2 kyu)**. White and white/yellow belts permitted for U8 divisions only. Yellow belt is the minimum rank for all other divisions.

We are including a Kata competition. To encourage participation there will be Senior and U23 Kata Divisions. See Kata Technical Package attached.

Entry Fees:

- \$35 U8/(white and white/yellow belts) U10 / U12 / U14 (yellow and yellow/orange belts)
- \$65 for all other divisions
- \$35 when competing in a 2nd division
- For Kata entry fees, please see Kata package

***Note:** As per Judo Canada athletes are allowed to compete in 2 divisions on the same day.

Eligibility: All participants must be members in good standing with their respective judo associations. Proof of valid membership may be requested at the weigh-in/ check-in.

I.J.F. Rules will apply, except for the following:

- It is the coach's responsibility to ensure that their judoka are wearing the appropriate Gis and undergarments for the competition. If coaches have any questions, please ask tournament officials before the beginning of competition.
- All competitors must have a White judogi.
- **U8, U10, U12, U14 white Gi is mandatory.** No exceptions will be made for switching judoka before a bout. Judoka unable to change to a white Gi **will lose by fusegachi**. If a judoka is called second by the tournament staff, they may fight in a blue Gi, if they so choose.
- Novice Divisions: U16, U18, U21 Senior, white Gi is mandatory. If a judoka is called second by the tournament staff, they may fight in a blue Gi, if they so choose. Judoka unable to change to a white Gi **will lose by fusegachi**.
- **IJF Divisions: U16, U18, U21, Senior Intermediate Blue and White judogi's are mandatory.**
- Girls & Women's divisions white t-shirts are mandatory.
- U8, U10, U12, U14 white t – shirts are optional for all competitors. No rash guards. Shirts & undergarments cannot extend beyond the length of the judogi. Judoka will be asked to remove coloured shirts or oversized undergarments.
- For U8, U10 and U12 divisions, the referee shall stop the match when:
 - Note: U8 white belt matches will be Ne-waza only.
- Head locking grip around the neck both in Tachi and ne waza. This includes kesa gatame, squeezing the neck and kubi nage.
- Drop Seoi-nage, Maki-komi, Tani-otoshi, and Sutemi-waza, and counter – rotation techniques are prohibited.
- *U14 and Senior Novice Yellow / Yellow – Orange, Orange prohibited actions:*
- Head locking grip around the neck in Tachi waza.
- Throws Seoi-otoshi, Tani-otoshi, Kubi nage, Maki-komi, and Sutemi-waza, and counter – rotation techniques on one leg.
- In the event there is a tie at the end of regulation time in U10, U12, U14
- U8, U10 – draw to both competitors
- U12 – 1.) the least number of shidos, 2.) Referees' decision based on kinsa, positive judo, and match control
- U14 - 1.) the least number of shidos, 2.) Referees' decision based on kinsa, positive judo, and match control

Elimination: Novice divisions U8, U10, U12, & U14 will be round robin. Judoka will be grouped accordingly.

All other Divisions will be modified double elimination. Divisions with less than 5 contestants will compete in a round-robin format with wins counted first, then points. If there are only 2 competitors in a division, it will be best two out-of-three.

Kata: See Kata Package attached.

Medals: **All medal recipients must be in their Judogi's when receiving medals.**

All U8, U10, U12 and, U14 Novice participants receive a participation award.

Medals will be awarded for first, second and third in all other divisions.

Participants must win at least one match to win a placement medal.

Medals will be awarded as soon as possible after each division is completed.
