What are player ratings?

- A way to assess and categorize a player's skill level.
- Ratings are typically expressed as a numerical value. ranging from beginner (1.0) to professional or expert levels (5.5+)



What are ratings used for?

- Matchmaking: Ensures balanced and competitive play in leagues, tournaments, or drop-in games.
- Tournaments: Players enter specific brackets based on their ratings.
- Improvement Tracking: Helps players set goals and measure progress.
