ELIGIBILITY:

Tournament Sanctioned A-level by Judo Canada.

Open to all members of Judo Provincial Associations, Judo Canada and IJF Associations of other countries.

U14 and U16 competitors must present identification at weigh in. U18 and over must show a valid *photo* identification at weigh in.

All foreign competitors must show documentation of a valid membership with their National Judo Association

Referees must hold a National C Level. Provincial Level may referee U10 and U12

^{**} The organizers reserve the right to modify or combine weight divisions, within the 15% weight allowance, in case of an inadequate number of participants.

NOTE: No athlete is allowed to compete in three different age divisions in this tournament.

Athletes can only fight in one division per day. However, the Ne-waza event is not included in this restriction.

U21 and older weigh in wearing only underclothing (t-shirt optional), no weight tolerance. Athletes are allowed to remove their underclothing – without stepping off the scales or briefly stepping of the scale if so, instructed by the official - to ensure they reach the minimum or the maximum weight limit of the weight category in which they are entered.

U14, U16 and U18 shall weigh-in wearing only underclothing (t-shirt optional). For these age groups, a tolerance of 0.2 kg is applied to accommodate for the weight of the underclothing. Athletes of these age divisions are NOT allowed to remove their underclothing.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

U10 and U12

- U10 & U12 competitors or designate must check in during weigh ins, prior to 8 PM Friday, January 24.
- Where possible, U10 & U12 groups will be made of up to 5 judokas of closest registered weight.
 Submission of incorrect/guessed weights may eliminate a judoka from participating.
- U10 & U12 do not weigh in but each Club Sensei is responsible to check their U10/U12 athletes' weight on Trackie for accuracy and advise of changes/errors before Friday, January 10.
- Round-Robin format will be used.
- Tournament regulations as per Judo Canada's Sanctioning Policy and Tournament Standards 2024-25.

U14, U16, U18, U21, Senior, Veteran, Ne-Waza

- The modified double elimination format will be used.
- In categories of 6 or 7, a double pool system will be used. In categories with 5 or fewer competitors, the round-robin format will be used. In categories of two, a best of three format will be used.
- Tournament regulations as per Judo Canada's Sanction Policy and Tournament Standards 2024-25.

All issues/cases(s) that are unexpected or deemed exceptional circumstances will be solved by decisions taken by the Tournament Director in consultation with the Chief Official.

No kansetu-waza or shime-waza are allowed for any match against a novice judoka (less than green belt).

A minimum of 2 competitors must be registered in a weight category for the competition to take place.

Both the blue and white judogis are mandatory for U16 and above. Reversible judogis will NOT be accepted. Single white judogi are permitted for U14 and younger. Female competitors must wear a plain, white t-shirt round neck (no v-neck) under their judogi.

No use of bleeding dyes on the body or hair of competitors is allowed. In cases such use is undetected and results in damage to the equipment of the opponent or the tatami, the competitor will be disqualified and the Provincial Association of which that individual is a member will be charged for the damage.

Judo Canada and Judo Saskatchewan (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to any property resulting from participation and travelling in connection with these championships.

AWARDS:

Medal winners must attend the medal ceremony in their WHITE judogi. Medal winners who refuse to participate in the ceremony will be removed from the result list and will not place (carding points may be removed). No promotion articles are authorized to be used/displayed on the podium (flags, T-shirt, socks or similar items).
