### Selection Criteria & Timelines

#### **OPEN SECTION: NON-INVITE**

There will be the option to compete in the OPEN section where this portion does not reward Category – 'C' points. This is open to the public and will take place prior to the main card. These races will run from 3:50pm – 5:30pm.

**\*Athletes who do not receive a lane in the invite section will be moved to the OPEN section**

Events in the OPEN Section:

**MPV, M800, W800, M200, W200, M1500m, W1500m, WLJ, M100, W100**

#### **INVITE SECTION**

This section will be the main card of the meet that will award Category 'C' level points. The meet will start at 6:30pm and will have prize money. Prize money will be distributed to the events based on the meet priority. The meet will prioritize the FEATURED events the most, PREMIUM secondary and INFERNO third. Prize per placing will be detailed later.

**FEATURED** – W800, M100m, MLJ

**PREMIUM** – WHJ, MHJ, W100mH, M1500m

**INFERNO** – M400H, W400mH, M400, W400, WSP, MSP, W1500, M800, W10K, M10K, M110H, W200m, WPV

**PARA** – based on raza point scoring
