- 2 long jump / triple jump pits
- 1 high jump area
- 1 pole vault area
- throws area that includes 1 hammer circle, 1 discus circle, 2 shot put circles, and 2 javelin runways. The warm-up area will be located adjacent to the backstretch of the stadium.

- 1. Only officials listed in the chart will be accredited. Those not included must purchase tickets to access the stadium.
- 2. Any final entry from any member federation that does not present itself for the championships will be penalized with \$100.00 (USD) for each athlete not present.

9. TRANSPORTATION & ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Official Airport

Grand Bahama International Airport (FPO) is the designated airport for all delegations arriving by air. It is located approximately 15 minutes from the athletes' accommodations.

Upon arrival, delegations will be received at the exit of the baggage claim area. Volunteers will guide teams to ground transportation to transfer to their accommodations.

Ground Transportation in Freeport – Grand Bahama

The Organizing Committee will provide ground transportation from **Wednesday**, **August 13**, **to Monday**, **August 18**, **2025**. Transportation schedules will be available at the Welcome Desk at each hotel.

Airport Transfers

Airport transportation services will only be available to delegations that have submitted completed **Arrival and Departure Forms**, including the name of the Member Federation, to the Local Organizing Committee. Team. Team Leaders must confirm departure details at their respective Welcome Desks.









Training Transportation

Bus transportation to and from Freeport Stadium for training will be provided as follows:

- August 14: 8:00 AM 12:00 PM and 2:00 PM 6:00 PM

Competition Transportation

Bahamas Travel Health Requirements

Member Federations are responsible for verifying with their country health department any specific requirements to enter Bahamas.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Unless otherwise stated, the 5th NACAC Athletics Championships will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of World Athletics (WA). All technical matters will be resolved in accordance with WA rules.

2. SAFEGUARDING

Safeguarding Standards

In accordance with the WA and NACAC Safeguarding Standards, and the recent WA decision at the 2024 Lima U-20 World Championship, NACAC has established that all delegations must have a Safeguarding Officer among their team members. 3. World Athletics Footwear Standards and Shoe Regulations

World Athletics regulates the thickness of athletic shoe soles to ensure fair competition and promote athlete safety. The maximum allowed thickness for track and field events is 20 millimeters for all distances and field events. This rule was implemented on November 1, 2024. Road races have a slightly higher limit of 40 millimeters.

Here's a breakdown of the regulations:

- Track and Field Events: All track and field events, including sprinters, distance runners, and field event athletes (like jumpers and throwers), are capped at 20mm sole thickness.
- **Road Races:** Road race shoes can have a sole thickness up to 40mm.
- **Enforcement:** World Athletics enforces these rules to ensure fair play and protect athletes from potentially harmful shoe technologies. They work with shoe manufacturers to understand the impact of new technologies and adjust rules as needed.

A minimum of three countries must submit entries by the deadline for the 10,000m events to be conducted at the Championships. If this requirement is not met, the event will be cancelled.









Relays

All mixed relay events will be conducted as timed finals. The fastest eight seed times will be placed in the final section. Seed times will be determined using performance rankings from the qualifying period: September 1, 2024, to August 1, 2025.

5. AGE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

Senior Athletes

Athletes born in 2005 or earlier (20 years of age or older).

Junior Athletes

Athletes born in 2007 or 2006 (ages 18 or 19) may participate in all events, provided they adhere to the event-specific heights, weights, and distances.

Youth Athletes

Athletes born in 2009 or 2008 (ages 16 or 17) may participate in events, provided they adhere to the event-specific heights, weights, and distances, except for the male throwing events, the 20,000m race walk, and the 3,000m steeplechase.

 Athletes aged 15 or younger (born in 2010 or later) are not eligible to participate.

6. Age Verification

Athletes will be required to present a valid Passport during the accreditation process to verify their age.









7. ATHLETES' ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted using the following criteria:

- By Event A maximum of two (2) athletes per country is allowed, except for events not run in lanes (1500m, 5000m, 3000m steeplechase, and 20,000m race walk), where up to four (4) athletes per country may enter.
 - For events allowing four (4) entries per country, in accordance with NACAC rules, only the top two (2) finishers from each Member Federation will count toward placing and medal standings.
- Relays: Only one (1) team per country is permitted.
- Minimum Standards: There are no minimum qualifying standards for entry.
- Qualification Period: Seed performances must fall within the qualification period of September 1, 2024, to August 1, 2025.

Final entries must be submitted online. For more details, refer to Appendix C.

8. PARTICIPATION CONFIRMATION

Upon arrival, delegations will receive several forms that must be completed and returned to the Technical Information Centre (TIC).

For relay events, each country may designate a pool of up to six (6) athletes, of which only four (4) may compete.









Forms confirming final participation must be submitted to the TIC according to the following schedule:








11. ENTRANCE CONTROL

The Athlete Control Centre (ACC) will be located southwest of the complex, south of the general admission. Athletes will present their personal accreditation and competition number to be able to enter the competition area in the track. The athletes must have spikes (maximum 6mm) except Javelin and High Jump (9mm), previously declared, and with the official uniform of the country he or she represents. The owner of the track can determine otherwise and declare to use 6mm. for all events, as good facility management.



The time for the entrance and exit to and from the Call Room will be the following:

Two calls will be made before the athletes go to the competition area. There will be 15 minutes between one call and the other and then the athlete will enter the track.

The athletes will enter the track accompanied by officials and will not be able to come out unless they are accompanied by an official.









12. COMPETITION NUMBERS

Each athlete will receive four (4) bibs: one with their name and three with their competition number. The name bib must be worn on the front. One number bib should be worn on the back (except for jumping events), one placed on the warm-up uniform, and the other attached to the athlete's bag to backpack. Bib placement will be checked in the Call Room to ensure all bibs are correctly assigned to the athlete.

13. START LISTS AND OFFICIAL RESULTS - PLEASE VERIFY

Start lists must be collected from the Technical Information Centre (TIC) prior to the start of each competition day. Official results will be provided only to the designated delegate of each country or to the individual appointed during the Technical Meeting.

Updated information—including news, entry lists, results, and photos—will be available on the official website before, during, and after each event.

The TIC will be located in the warm-up area and will serve as the central hub for all event-related information. A complete Results Report will be distributed to all delegations at the conclusion of the Championships.

14. PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be distributed in all events. The amount for each event and position will be notified in a future newsletter.

15. TECHNICAL INFORMATION CENTER (TIC)

The Technical Information Centre (TIC) will be located at the stadium. Each hotel will also have an Information Desk near the lobby.









The TIC, located near the warm-up area at the stadium, will manage the following:

- Technical information
- Official messages for Delegates
- Distribution of official results
- General information (transportation, meals, accommodation)

16. MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical personnel and paramedics will be on duty throughout the competition. Physiotherapy services will also be available for all delegations.

17. POST COMPETITION PROCEDURES

17.1 General

All athletes must exit the track through the mixed zone, where media may conduct brief interviews. Athletes selected for doping control will be escorted from the mixed zone. Others will proceed to the award ceremony or return to the warm-up area.

17.2 Exit Procedures

- 17.2.1 Track Events: Immediately after the finish line.
- 17.2.2 Field Events (Final Rounds): After the first three (3) attempts and again after the final three (3) attempts.
- 17.2.3 Long Jump & Triple Jump: Athletes proceed directly to the mixed zone. If selected, they will be escorted to doping control or the award ceremony.
- 17.2.4 High Jump & Pole Vault: Athletes exit together at the conclusion of the event and proceed to the mixed zone. If selected, they will be escorted to doping control or the award ceremony.









18. PROTOCOL CEREMONIES

Award Ceremonies

Athletes placing in the top three (3) of each event must report to the podium in medal order and must wear their official national team uniform. Award ceremonies will occur following the posting of official results, per World Athletics & NACAC Athletics protocol procedures. A detailed schedule will be available at the TIC.

20. JURY OF APPEALS

The NACAC Athletics Council will appoint the Jury of Appeals. (The members are listed on page 4.)

Appeals Process:

- Appeals must first be submitted to the Referee of the respective event.
- If unresolved, appeals may then be submitted to the Jury of Appeals via the following process:
 - Complete the official Appeal Form, provided during the Technical Meeting.
 - The form must be signed by the Delegate or Team Leader.
 - Submit the appeal at the TIC at the National Stadium within 30 minutes of the official result announcement.
 - A deposit of \$100 USD must accompany each appeal.
 - Appeal decisions will be posted at the TIC Bulletin Board and Press Center.
 - Award ceremonies for the event in question will be suspended until the appeal is resolved.

21. DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with World Athletics regulations, doping control will take place in a designated area at the National Stadium.

Athletes selected for testing will be notified at the end of their event and must be accompanied by a Doping Control Official throughout the process. Athletes must complete and sign all required forms. Each athlete may be accompanied by a team official and a translator, if needed, from their delegation.









22. FACILITIES AND IMPLEMENTS

- The competition will take place on a 400-meter, 8-lane track equipped with a false start detection system.
- Race walk events will be held on the track.
- A designated warm-up area must be used for all pre-competition activities.
- The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will provide World Athleticsapproved implements. A list will be shared in a bulletin prior to the Championships.
- Athletes may bring personal implements (discus, javelin, shot put, hammer, pole vault) for use, subject to approval by the Technical Delegate. These must be submitted for inspection and weighing on the day before the 1st session and the morning of the 4th and 5th sessions.
- The Team Delegate must declare personal implements at the TIC after the Technical Meeting.
- Approved implements will be stored at the National Stadium and returned after the event. A voucher system will be used.
- Each delegation is responsible for transporting its implements to and from the competition.

23. RULES FOR THE USE OF THE TRACK

Access to the track and field during the Championships is restricted to:

- Competing athletes
- Event officials and designated volunteers
- Authorized NACAC Council Members and LOC personnel
- Accredited media, including a limited number of photographers

Marshals will ensure that only authorized individuals are in the competition area. Coaches and other unauthorized personnel must remain in designated viewing areas.









24. TECHNICAL MEETING

The Technical Meeting will be held at Grand Lucayan Hotel on Thursday, August 14, 2025, at 7:00 PM.

Prior to the meeting, beginning at 4:00 PM in the same location, the LOC will distribute competition numbers and preliminary entries for delegate review.

All written questions must be submitted by noon **on Thursday, August 14, 2025**, using the form in Appendix E (also available at the TIC) or via email to michtarm@gmail.com and mserralta.nacac@gmail.com. No questions will be taken from the floor.

The meeting will be conducted in English with Spanish translation and will be presided over by the Technical Delegate. Two delegates per country may attend.

Appendix A: Visa Requirements

Do I need a Visa?

Obtaining a visa invitation letter from the Local Organizing Committee (LOC)

For everyone or group who requires a visa, the LOC Visa Information Form must be completed in all its sections so that the required invitation letter for the purpose of visa application can be properly issued.

This form must be sent to the:

When completing the LOC Visa Information Form, please make sure that:

- Each passport has two consecutive blank visa-designated pages
- The expiry date of the passport is at least six months after the last day of the expected stay in Grand Bahama.
- If the passport does not meet these two requirements, a new passport must be obtained, or the existing one is to be prolonged before you can request the invitation letter.
- You indicate in which Consulate you will make your application. Follow this link to find the consular information for The Bahamas.

After receiving receipt of the completed LOC Visa Information Form, the LOC will issue, and email you, the official invitation letter. You will be able to print as many copies as needed for the members of your group. The visa invitation letter will enable a person to apply for entry visa to The Bahamas for the period from August 1 to 30, 2025. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs requires Visa for the following countries:
