06 RULES

Format of all age divisions as per current **Judo Canada Sanctioning Policy & Tournament Standards** unless specified below. Any modification to the recommended format must be approved by Judo Canada in advance.

- All issues/cases(s) that are unexpected or deemed exceptional circumstances will be solved by decisions taken by the Tournament Director.
- White judogi is mandatory for U10, U12, U14, Novice divisions, Veterans & Intermediate. Blue judogi is optional.
- White & blue judogis are mandatory for U16 & older. Exception: Novice divisions, Veterans and Intermediate.

U10, U12

- All athletes of the age group U12 and younger shall weigh-in wearing judogi pants and t-shirt, no exceptions, and no weight tolerance is granted.
- Weigh-in: Honor System (Provided by the parents, checked by club coach). There will be a scale for spot checks should concerns arise. We ask that Club Instructors verify the athlete's weights. Discrepancies of over 5% between reported weights and actual weights may result in disqualification without refund.
- Tournament format:
 - » Round robin maximum 5 athletes per pool
 - » 2 min running time (U10), 2 ippon
 - » 2 min of stopped time (U12), 1 ippon
 - » No golden score
- In the absence of a technical score or equal technical score at the end of the bout, the winner is determined by a decision of the referee(s).
- Competitors will be placed in groups by age, weight and belt level, as entries permit.
- Contest Rules, Match Times, and Divisions: as per Judo Canada tournament sanctioning policy. Matches will be officiated, and scores called but not recorded. Wins will be recognized.

COMPETITION FORMAT

- The modified double elimination format will be used.
- In weight categories with seven (7) or fewer competitors, the pool system format will be used. In weight categories with five (5) or fewer competitors, the round-robin format will be used.



07 EARLY BLOOMER

If an athlete would like to compete in an age division above their standard age division, Early Bloomer waiver must be submitted during the registration. Early Bloomer waiver must be signed by both a parent and a coach. Early Bloomer waiver is available on the main page of the Trackie registration.

- Birth Year of 2015 must complete and upload an earlier bloomer waiver to fight in U14.
- Birth Year of 2013 & 2014 must complete and upload an earlier bloomer waiver to fight in U16.
- Birth Year of 2012 must complete and upload an earlier bloomer waiver to fight in U18, U21 or Senior

Deadline for early bloomer approval is same as entry deadlines. Please refer to Section 03: Entry Fees & Entry Deadlines.

08 WEIGH-IN/CHECK-IN

Please note:

- Athletes are only required to weigh-in once.
- To keep the tournament on schedule, no change requests will be accepted after 1h before the competition bloc starts
- Remote weigh-in could be added upon request, must be requested before October 12th, 2025 to be approved
- Remote weigh-in requirements:

Athletes are only required to weigh-in once. Athletes who are fighting 2 days will need to weigh in at the designated time for the first day competition. For the second day competition, athletes will be considered "checked-in" for their second day competition, unless notification is given by the athlete, parent, or coach to the organization(info@peakjudo.ca) that they are unable to compete. Please notify us no later than 6:00 pm on Sat, Oct 25, 2025.



09 COACHES, REFEREE & KATA JUDGES

Coach Eligibility: Minimum Dojo Instructor Trained or equivalent)

Referee Eligibility U10, U12: Need at least 1 Mini Shiai as a referee

Referee Eligibility U14, U16, U18, U21, Senior & Veterans: Provincial D and higher (No certification might be accepted by the referee committee)

Referee Evaluations: Provincial A, B, C and D

Kata Judges Eligibility: Certified National and higher, in the kata that they are judging.

10 AWARDS

In the U10 & U12 divisions every competitor will receive the same medal. For all other divisions, medals will be awarded for first, second and third place according to the Judo Canada Tournament Standards. All medal winners must win at least one match. Medals will be awarded after the division is completed.

Medalists are required to wear their white judogi on the podium (like if they are about to compete)
