### Tournament Format

**Division 1** Skill Level 2.5

**Division 2** Skill Level 3.0

**Division 3** Skill Level 3.5

### Scoring

Games play to 11, win by 2

If time runs out, highest score wins and is recorded (ex: 9-5)

If tied at the end of time, play continues:

- One additional rally will be played

- Serving is determined by a coin toss

- Team that wins the rally wins the game

- The winning point is added to the final game score

If game goes past 11, whatever the final score is, it is recorded as 11-9

## Time-outs

One 30 second time-out per team per game

Time-outs do not increase total game time and game time is locked at maximum of 20 minutes

## Timing

The schedule is an approximation and subject to change

Maximum 20 minutes per match

5 minutes between matches to get to your court & warm-up

Start & End of matches occurs when the cowbell rings

### Division 1 (2.5)

**8 - Teams**

**Arrive 11:20 AM (11:50 AM Start)**

Round Robin play

Each team in Division 1 will play against every other team once

Each team plays 7 matches

Top 4 Teams advance to playoff rounds

In the event of a tie:

Total Points scored over all games

Point Differential +/-

**Semifinal 1:** #1 vs. #4

**Semifinal 2:** #2 vs. #3

**Final 1:** Winner Semifinal 1 vs. Winner Semifinal 2

**Final 2:** Runner-up Semifinal 1 vs. Runner-up Semifinal 2

### Division 2 (3.0)

**11 – Teams**

**Arrive 3:30 PM (4:00 PM Start)**

Divided into two pools (A, B).

**Pool A:** Team A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, A6

**Pool B:** Team B1, B2, B3, B4, B5

Each team plays against every other team in their pool once

Top two teams from each pool advance to the playoffs

In the event of a tie:

Total Points scored over all games  
Point Differential +/-

Playoffs:

**Semifinal 1:** Winner Pool A vs. Runner-up Pool B

**Semifinal 2:** Winner Pool B vs. Runner-up Pool A

**Final 1:** Winner Semifinal 1 vs. Winner Semifinal 2

**Final 2:** Runner-up Semifinal 1 vs. Runner-up Semifinal 2

### **Division 3 (3.5)**

**15 Teams**

**Arrive 8:00 AM (8:30 AM Start)**

Divided into two pools (A, B)

**Pool A:** Team A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, A8

**Pool B:** Team B1, B2, B3, B4, B5, B6, B7

Each team plays against every other team in their pool once.

Top four teams from each pool advance to the playoffs

In the event of a tie:

Total Points scored over all games  
Point Differential +/-

Playoffs:

**Quarterfinals 1:** 1st A vs 4th B

**Quarterfinals 2:** 1st B vs 4th A

**Quarterfinals 3:** 2nd A vs 3rd B

**Quarterfinals 4:** 2nd B vs 3rd A

**Semifinal 1:** Winner QF 1 vs. Winner QF 4

**Semifinal 2:** Winner QF 2 vs. Winner QF 3

**Final 1:** Winner Semifinal 1 vs. Winner Semifinal 2

**Final 2:** Runner-up Semifinal 1 vs. Runner-up Semifinal 2

## Tournament Rules

### 1. Self-Officiating:

- Players are responsible for making their own line calls and keeping track of the score.
- If there is a disagreement, players should discuss it calmly and come to a mutual agreement.

### 2. Line Calls:

- The receiving team players should call the ball "in" or "out" based on their best judgment.
- If there is any doubt, the benefit of the doubt should go to the team that hit the ball, and the ball should be considered "in."

### 3. Scorekeeping:

- Players should announce the score loudly and clearly before serving.
- Both teams should keep track of the score to avoid any confusion.
- Following the completion of the game, one player per team report to the Tournament Marshall to record the score.

### 4. Disputes:

- In case of a dispute, players should try to resolve it amicably.
- If an agreement cannot be reached, players must replay the point.

### 5. Conduct:

- Players should maintain good sportsmanship and respect their opponents.
- Any unsporting behavior should be addressed immediately.

### 6. Faults and Violations:

- Players should call their own faults, such as foot faults or double hits.
- If a player commits a fault, they should acknowledge it and concede the point.
- If an agreement cannot be reached, players must replay the point.

### 7. Time Limits:

- Matches have 20-minute time limit to ensure that play proceeds smoothly.
- Players should be mindful of the time and keep the game moving.
- Enter and exit the court in a timely manner.
- If a player is more than **5 minutes late**, then their team will forfeit the match, and their opponent wins the game 11-0.

### 8. Warm-Up:

- A brief warm-up is allowed before each match.

- Players should be ready to start their matches promptly to keep the game on schedule.
- Start & End of matches occurs when the cowbell rings

### 9. Injury & Withdraws

If a player is injured, they are allowed a 5-minute medical time-out.

Time-outs do not increase total game time and game time is locked a maximum 20 minutes

- If a team withdraws due to injury or other reason, then all games for that team, played or not, do not count and are nullified.
