

Barrie Pickleball Club Guest Policy & Procedure

Local non-member residents are welcome to play as a guest, during club events, up to 2 times, after which they must become a member, provided:

- 1) there is space in the events, and
- 2) membership is open.

A local resident is generally defined as anyone within a 1-hour driving radius of Barrie.

Guests outside of the 1-hour driving radius will be assessed guest playing privileges on a reasonable and individual basis.

Examples of non-local Guests:

- 1) a player visiting Barrie from Florida for a week, will be permitted to play at the discretion of the club for the duration of their 1-week visit.
- a player living outside of the 1-hour driving radius, wishing to play regularly in the summer, fall or winter seasons must join the club and/or event after their maximum allowed 2 guest passes if space allows.

Guest Liability Waiver

All guests are required to sign a liability waiver before joining any scheduled Club event. The waiver can be found on the bottom left corner of the <u>Barrie Pickleball Club's website</u> under "Additional Documents".

The following process should be followed for individuals wishing to attend as a guest:

1. Email request to events@barriepickleballclub.ca with your request and include a signed guest waiver. A \$6 fee may apply.
