The primary objective of the Golden Bears and Pandas Preview is to provide a season opening competitive opportunity for USPORTS athletes and other athletes in the AB region. Registration is still accepted from other provinces

All USPORTS events are governed by Canada West Playing Regulations
All Club window – U12/ U14 / U16 / U18 / U20 / Senior / Masters events are governed by WA rules

#### **Eligibility:**

Athletes and coaches must appear on a formal USPORTS eligibility roster OR be active member of their respective provincial athletics association. International athletes should contact the meet director.

Seed marks are subject to verification using Athletics Canada Indoor Rankings or USPORTS Rankings (Jan 1 2024 – Dec 31, 2025). Special requests for speculative seeds not found in either of the two primary ranking systems must be sent to meet director by Thursday January 1 at NOON, with clear rationale provided in order to be considered.

GBP-P (Jan 4, 2026)

Track: U14/U16/U18/U20/Senior/Masters: no entry limits: 60m, 60mH, 200m

<u>Field:</u> Weight Throw, Shot Put, Triple Jump, Long Jump, High Jump, Pole Vault

\*\*\*U14 hurdles will use 30" heights. Masters hurdlers are welcome to enter at Open specifications, and 30" hurdle heights will be the lowest used\*\*\*

### **Entry Limits – GBP-Preview**

Field event entry limits are imposed at the GBP-P (Jan 3, 2026) event. Totals include Golden Bears and Pandas Athletes.

Pole Vault = 14 entries and minimum 2025 mark of 3.20m

60m Hurdles Heats 12:00PM

60m Hurdles Finals \*\*minimum 30 minutes between hurdle heats and finals

60m Heats

60m Finals \*\*minimum 45 minutes between 60m heats and finals

600m Timed final

200m \*\*minimum 45 minutes between 60m final and 200m

### Preferred Lanes, order of events and advancements:

Preferred lanes: Oval preferred = 6/7/5/4/3/2/1Order of events: Timed finals run FAST to SLOW

#### Alternates in finals:


For events having heats and finals, alternates in the finals will be listed. Meaning, if 8 athletes advance to the final, places 9-11 will be listed as alternates. Alternates will be permitted to race in the final should scratches occur in time.
