



WELCOME TO THE CHARLOTTETOWN PIKLEBALL CLUB - WINTER 2026

JANUARY 9, 2026 UPDATED

You've been invited to join the club, now what?

We're excited to welcome you and want to provide instructions on how to register with:

- Our club
- Pickleball Canada (mandatory for insurance)
- Our registration system (pickleballsignuphub.com)
- Our Charlottetown DUPR Club (if you have a DUPR rating)

The first step is to go to Pickleball Canada and register: <https://pickleballcanada.org/membership/join-renew/> Select JOIN, Enter Province, Select Charlottetown Pickleball Club. You'll see our page at this point with the multi-coloured pickleballs. Select JOIN-RENEW and provide the requested information. Select 2026 Annual Membership Full Payment and go from there.

Payment process:

\$0.00 Charlottetown Pickleball Club annual membership (the real cost is \$95 which you pay by e-Transferring to the club-see the next step).

Via credit card payment, pay \$16.42 to Pickleball Canada (\$10.00 Pickleball Canada membership, \$5.00 to PEI Pickleball (our provincial governing body), and \$1.42 Pickleball Canada processing fee. This membership is mandatory.

Next, e-Transfer \$95.00 to: charlottetownpickleballclub@gmail.com

Let us know in the memo section what it's for.

We use a program called PickleballSignUpHub to access and sign up for sessions. Go here to register: <https://www.pickleballsignuphub.com/index.php>

We use a system of play credits to pay for sessions, which you purchase in advance. We offer three amounts.

- 20 credits for \$20.00
- 50 credits for \$47.50
- 100 credits for \$90.00

Let us know in the memo section what it's for. As with the membership fee, e-transfer to: charlottetownpickleballclub@gmail.com

The final step is to register with DUPR. DUPR stands for Dynamic Universal Pickleball Rating and it's the system we use to determine what sessions people have access to. Although registration with DUPR is free, they will try to get you to pay for an annual deluxe membership. DON'T DO IT. If you have any problems at this point, please let me know before you proceed.

Our registration volunteer will accept your registration to Pickleball Hub and to our Charlottetown DUPR Club and then you will be good to go.

DUPR Ratings & Open/ Recreation Play

We encourage all of our approximately 300 members to obtain a DUPR (Dynamic Universal Pickleball Rating). For more information about this trusted worldwide rating program visit: <https://www.dupr.com/>. As a registered DUPR Club, we use these ratings to group players by skill level for fair and competitive play. Everyone pays the same membership fee but DUPR members get extra play opportunities so we encourage all of our players to get rated. We currently have 158 Charlottetown DUPR Club.

You can earn a DUPR rating by:

1. Participating in club-organized DUPR sessions (we upload your scores)
2. Booking a \$45 observed session with DUPR coach Parker Fisher
3. If you already have a DUPR rating, please sign in, find the Charlottetown DUPR Club, and request to join.

Scheduling & Fees

Before signing up for sessions, please review our schedule and fee structure:

- We use pickleballsignuphub.com to manage weekly sign-ups for indoor and outdoor sessions
- Weekly sign-ups (Monday–Sunday) open every Saturday at 7 pm
- After registering, login and click the “Venue Sign up” button on our Pickleball Canada club page to view sessions and register

Play Credits

- The club uses a play credits system to pay for sessions. Send an e-transfer to charlottetownpickleballclub@gmail.com in one of the following amounts: \$20 for 20 credits/ \$47.50 for 50 credits/ \$90 for 100 credits (save \$10!)
- Please allow time for processing as credit entry is not automatic. We do this for each person.
- Session Fees: 3 play credits for 1.5–2 hour sessions at public schools and UPEI/ \$5 for Le Carrefour / Atlantic Pickleball Club - to be determined
- Credits are deducted automatically deducted when you register

Cancellations & Waitlists

- Sessions with fewer than four players are cancelled
- Sign in and cancel early to allow others to join from the waitlist
- Cancel 12+ hours before the session to receive a credit refund
- Members are responsible for monitoring their sign-ups, credit balance, and session status. We are not able to monitor this so let Todd Fraser know if you need a refund and why.

Game Formats

We use a variety of doubles formats:

- Randomized play based on wins/losses (first to 11, win by 2)
- Round robin (first to 11, win by 2) or timed games
- Player caps (six per court) to minimize wait times
- Winner and non-winner bins to organize players

2026 Winter Venues & Schedules

6. Le Carrefour – 4 courts, evenings & weekends
7. West Royalty School – late afternoons & weekends, Mon–Sat
8. UPEI Sports Centre – weekdays & Monday evenings

 - Wear indoor, non-marking shoes
 - showers available
 - Parking available with a 12-month \$70 Walking Track Membership
 - Parking free evenings and weekends

- Stay hydrated; bring cooling towels and water
- If you have a medical condition (e.g., diabetes), inform others and bring necessary supplies to the gym
- Stretch before and after play
- Report injuries — an incident form will be provided upon request
