**Technical Venue Information** – Saskatoon Field House is a 200m flat oval track – Mondo surface, replaced in 2019. 6 lane oval, 8 lane straight, all events accommodated. Spikes are to be Christmas tree or pyramid. No needle/pin spikes. If it really hurts to press your thumb down on the pin (could draw blood), then these are NOT allowed.

### **Entry Fees (per Canada West Policy #16 Finance – Section 5.5)**

#### *5.5. Canada West Track and Field Championships*

*To assist schools with the cost of hosting the Track and Field Championships, visiting teams will pay the host school \$750/school plus \$20/athlete. The track and field hosts will invoice the visiting members, independently of the CW Office. This is not intended to cover the full cost of hosting the Championships. (i.e. a team travelling 47 athletes would pay \$1,690 to the host, whereas a team travelling with 27 athletes would pay \$1,290 to the host). Institutions will be invoiced post championship.*

**Community Service Award Nominations** – Submissions will occur via online google form. Deadline to submit nominations is Tuesday February 17<sup>th</sup> (midnight) so that details can be circulated amongst Head Coaches for review with voting to commence post competition (Saturday afternoon).

**Awards (Male and Female)** – Rookie of the Year, Athlete of the Year – Track, Athlete of the Year – Field, Outstanding Performance of the Championships, Assistant Coach of the Year, Coach of the Year.

The following information will clarify the medical and therapy services available during your stay at the University of Saskatchewan. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me by phone or e-mail. We look forward to hosting you and your teams at the U of S.

<b>Services Provided</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* A Huskie physiotherapist or student trainer will share venue specific information and will discuss the appropriate emergency action protocol with the visiting medical staff prior to competition time. A copy of the EAP will be provided to the visiting team.</li> <li>* A Huskie physiotherapist and student therapist(s) will be on site.</li> <li>* Host medical will assist with emergency situations.</li> <li>* Visiting teams to provide their own medical representative. Team may contact Host Head Therapist for list of external contractors to secure coverage in the absence of a travelling team medical personnel.</li> <li>* Visiting teams are encouraged to utilize Host Medical Staff for assistance with return to play decisions. Host Medical Staff will make recommendations within their applicable scope of practice. Final decision to lie with the visiting team.</li> <li>* There will be no host medical coverage during practices.</li> <li>* All supplies must be provided by the visiting team or a charge will apply.</li> <li>* Should emergency transport to the Hospital be required, the EAP will outline the protocol via ambulance transport. USask will not be responsible for any charges associated with emergency transportation of visiting athletes, team staff or spectators. Emergency transportation will be arranged through Medavie Health Services Ambulance. Non-emergency transport will be the responsibility of the visiting team.</li> <li>* All athletes must travel with provincial health card information.</li> </ul>

<b>Emergency Equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* The host therapist will review the emergency supplies available and their location prior to the competition.</li> <li>* Ice, ice bags, and water will be supplied to the visiting team.</li> <li>* Biohazardous waste management agents and disposal devices supplied.</li> <li>* AED, oxygen and delivery devices, fracture kit, immobilizers, slings, scoop stretcher, spine board, crutches and blanket are available in case of an injury.</li> </ul>		
<b>Concussion Management</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Visiting student-athletes that may have sustained a concussion are strongly encouraged to access host medical staff to aid in return to sport decision making</li> <li>* Any student-athlete that has sustained a potential head injury should be removed from play and not return to any activity that day.</li> <li>* Visiting teams should contact host health medical staff to access a private/quiet area for concussion assessment and management.</li> <li>* Visiting teams are strongly recommended to travel with a representative who has completed the Concussion Awareness Training Tool seminar that is recommended by USPORTS</li> </ul>		
<b>Training Room</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* The host medical staff will have an identified first aid room for visiting teams.</li> </ul>		
<b>Clinic Access and Therapy Services</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Visiting athletes who require injury assessment or treatment from USask healthcare providers require prior written notification from their therapist to the Head Therapist.</li> <li>* Treatment times are by appointment only during the competition.</li> </ul>		
<b>Injury Communication</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Host medical staff will complete a CW Injury Report Form for any injured athlete reviewed at the competition. A copy of the injury reports will be made available to the participant.</li> </ul>
