SANCTIONS	This event is applying for BC Athletics, Athletics Canada, World Athletics and World Para Athletics sanctions in place
ELIGIBILITY	Current BC Athletics competitive membership or equivalent from another provincial or state association.
REGISTRATION	Registration is through Trackie https://www.trackie.com/event/CWG-last-chance Email registrations will not be accepted. Athletes must register under a club or as independent; Registration will not be allowed under a school.

ENTRY FEES	\$20.00 per event Entry fees for athletes' part of the Para Development Camp will be waived
ENTRY DEADLINES	All entries must be received no later than 11:00 pm, Wednesday March 18, 2026. No online or emailed entries will be accepted after this time.
LATE ENTRIES	No entries will be accepted after March 18, 2026. There will be no "day of" event registration
MEET RULES	ATHLETICS CANADA and WORLD ATHLETICS and WORLD PARA ATHLETICS rules and regulations will apply at this meet.
AWARDS	There will be no medals awarded at this event. Results will be based on LA2028 Medal Events and classification combinations.

CATEGORIES	U18 , U20, Seniors, and Masters may compete together as an OPEN category. Para Ambulatory will be integrated into the OPEN category, with separate events for wheelchair racing and seated throws.
EVENTS	Open Men's: 100m, 400m, 3000m, Discus, Shot Put Open Women's: 100m, 200m, 3000m, Discus Wheelchair Men's: 100m, 400m, Shot Put Wheelchair Women's: 100m, 400m, Shot Put
ATHLETE CHECK IN TRACK EVENTS	Athletes must check in at the start line at least 15 minutes prior to scheduled starting time for all track events. We will follow all starting times for track events as listed in the published schedule of events. Any changes to the field event schedule will be listed in a revised schedule available at the meet and posted on Trackie. Please make note when registering your athletes that our field event schedule is extremely tight and we will not hold up any field events for athletes participating in other events. Have your athletes check over the schedule before registering in this meet.
ATHLETE CHECK IN FIELD EVENTS	Athletes must check in to their field event at least 10 minutes in advance of the scheduled time.
SPIKE LENGTHS	The maximum spike length allowed on this track is 7mm.
TRACK RESTRICTIONS	The infield is <i>out of bounds</i> at all times as the infield is used for competition. Please use the main entrance to the stadium and walk around to the finish line seating from the flagpole end of the track. Please observe all restricted areas.
EQUIPMENT	Throws implements and starting blocks will be provided by Athletics Victoria. Personal equipment must be checked and weighed in the equipment shed under the electronic scoreboard at least 1 hour before the start of the throwing event. Contact the meet director if you need to locate an official to weigh your equipment.
TIMED FINALS	Some events offered are timed finals. Please refer to the Meet Schedule for details
RACE NUMBERS	Numbers will be assigned to all athletes and must be worn during all competitions. Track events from 100 to 400 metres will have numbers on the back. Track events 600 metres and longer will have numbers on the front. Field event numbers may be worn on the back or the front.
CAMPING	No overnight parking is permitted within the University of Victoria boundaries. Campus Security will patrol the campus and will remove any groups camping on site.
