


Debbie Miller Classic Track & Field Meet

Facilities: Pauline Johnson Collegiate has an 8-lane track finished in 2017. **All weather (rubber) surface** for all track and jumping events. Javelin will be thrown on a grass runway. Shot put circle is concrete. A portable discus circle will be used.

Awards: Awards will be distributed for winners of each individual event

Debbie Miller will present a special award to the **overall fastest male and female 100m runners**

Rick Mannen will present a special award to the **overall fastest male and female 1500m runners**

Entry Fee: \$15 per athlete (may compete in up to 3 individual events + unlimited relays)

Maximum fee: **\$500 per school**

Parking: Parking is available at Mohawk Park

Officiating: All duties will be carried out by volunteer coaches

For long and triple jump, athletes will have 3 attempts

For throwing events, athletes will have 3 attempts and then the top 8 should get an additional 3 throws

Participants are responsible for the safety of their own belongings and medical needs.
Maximum spike length is 6mm on all track and runway surfaces.

For safety reasons, throwing implements are only to be used in the supervised competition areas for shot put, discus and javelin. Footballs, frisbees, soccer balls and other throwing/kicking equipment are not permitted at the Pauline Johnson CVS Track and Field Facility and corresponding parks.
