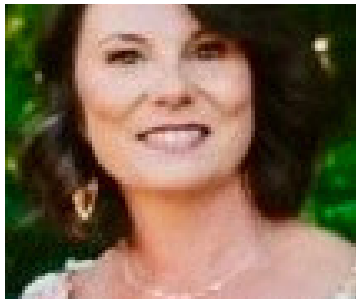

Presidents year-in-review

Approximately 40 members and guests attended the 3rd AGM of the CPC. Club Founder and President Lisa Murphy delivered her final year-end report, highlighting a strong and active season. The club provided its full membership (capped at 300) with an average of 100 hours of court time across six school venues. It was noted that the club needs a dedicated facility to meet demand, expand membership for residents and visitors, and include youth players.

Lisa thanked several key supporters: Stephanie Knickle, Sports Centre Facility Manager, for her support since the club's inception; Parker Fisher for his early help establishing the club; and Mayor Philip Brown and Manager Frank Quinn for the City of Charlottetown's role in building the Hillsborough Park venue. She also welcomed Jonah MacMillan, representing the Atlantic Pickleball Club.

The club's adoption of DUPR, a worldwide rating system, was recognized as an important milestone. As a designated DUPR Club, it now offers structured sessions for players of similar skill levels, alongside open and recreational play. With support from volunteer coaches and certified instructors, members benefited from numerous drills, clinics, and development opportunities throughout the year.

Social connection remained a hallmark of the club, with well-attended gatherings at Founders Hall and a summer social hosted by a member. The club continues to enjoy a strong community profile and active social media presence. Lisa thanked her Executive Team, with special appreciation to Todd Fraser, outgoing VP and Treasurer and incoming PT Club Manager, for the significant work accomplished together. She concluded her final report with pride in the partnerships built, achievements of the membership, and the trust placed in her to lead the club.



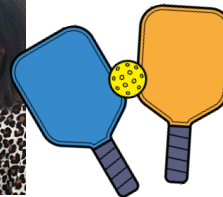
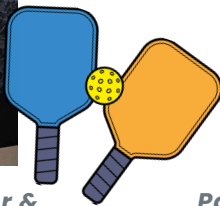
