- **U12:** Under 12 as of Dec. 31, 2026 (born 2015 or later)
- **U14:** Under 14 as of Dec. 31, 2026 (born 2013 or 2014)
- **U16:** Under 16 as of Dec. 31, 2026 (born 2011 or 2012)
- **U18:** Under 18 as of Dec. 31, 2026 (born 2009 or 2010)
- **U20:** Under 20 as of Dec. 31, 2026 (born 2007 or 2008)
- **Senior:** 20 and older as of Dec. 31, 2026 (born 2006 or earlier)
- **Masters:** 35 and older on day of meet (born July 4th, 1991 or earlier)

(Para athletes competing in other events are to register with proper age group).

4. Scratches: Please report scratches the meet office as soon as possible.

5. Protests: Protests must be submitted in writing to the meet office no later than one-half hour following the official posting of results. Protests must be accompanied by a \$50.00 deposit which may be forfeited if the protest is disallowed.

6. Entry Deadline:

The late entry deadline for the meet is: **8:00pm MT, Sunday, June 28th, 2026**

- Late Fees: A late entry fee double the original fee will be charged.
