ENTRIES (US dollars at Par) DEADLINE midnight, Sunday June 11th, 2017

With the goal of putting athletes in heats/sections with athletes of similar abilities, the 2017 edition of the Langley Pacific Invitational will experiment with combining the 16-34 year old age categories to compete in a single category unless technical specifications will not allow. Heats/sections will be drawn based on seed performances. We hope this change will produce superior performances.

The following events will be combined into a single 16-34 age category and heats/sections will be drawn based on seed performances:

100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 400m hurdles (women), Long Jump, Triple Jump, High Jump, Pole Vault, Discus (women)

**The following events will have a Youth category
Sprint Hurdles, Shot Put, Javelin, Hammer, Discus (Men), Steeplechase**

**The following events will have a Junior Category
Sprint Hurdles (Men), Discus (Men), Hammer (Men), Shot Put (Men)**

- All Pacific Invitational fees are \$10.00 per event
- Girls Pentathlon (Friday night) entry fee is \$25.00
- All Masters Championship fees are \$20.00 per event
- Little Rascals: \$10 for all 4 events combined. Entries will be done at the track Sat. or Sun.

Divisions:

- Junior Development (J.D.): (9 -13) single age groupings.
- Midget (14-15),
- **Open (16-34 years old except where technical specifications will not allow)**
- Little Rascals (age 6,7,8)
- Masters (scored in 5 year intervals)
- Late entries may not receive correct seeding

Late Registration and Fee

- After, June 11th, 2017, all Langley Pacific entries will be charged \$20.00 for each event
- After June 11th, 2017 all Master's late entries will be charged \$30 for each event.

Finalists-60M and 100M

- 60/100M events with 8 or less competitors will be run as a final at the time of the heats.
- All other track events will be run as finals
- Finalist will be determined by IAAF Rules

Track Events

- Events may be run up to 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time

BC Athletics Membership

- All Masters must be a BCA member or equivalent in another jurisdiction to complete.

Throws & Horizontal Jumps

- Ages 9-13 receive will receive 3 attempts
- Midget through Open and Masters receive 3 attempts; top eight qualify for 3 additional

Conflicting Track/Field Events

- To avoid missing jumps or races, athletes should report to BOTH event Officials. Athletes cannot "catch up" on missed rounds of throws/jumps.

Results

- Results will be posted at the track and on www.langleymustangs.com

Awards

- First Nation designed medals will be available. Ribbons: 4th through 8th.
- BC Masters competitors will receive BC Athletic Medals
- Medals MUST be picked up at the meet – there will be NO mail out of medals or ribbons

Protests

- After discussion with the event referee, further protest must be submitted in writing to the Chief of Officials and the Jury of Appeal within 30 minutes of the posting of the results.
- A \$25.00 protest fee is to accompany all protests. If the protest is upheld then the protest fee will be returned. JURY OF APPEAL: A jury of appeal consisting of three competent and qualified persons will be available for decisions arising from protests. All Jury of Appeal decisions are final.
